TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Georgia Eagle Broadcasting, Inc. ("GEB"), licensee of station WDXQ-FM, Channel 244A, Cochran, Georgia. GEB is submitting an amendment to a pending application which proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WDXQ-FM; therefore, a Radio Market analysis is needed. GEB is also the licensee of WDCO, 1440 kHz, Cochran, Georgia; WSSY, Channel 252A, Pinehurst, Georgia; WQXZ, Channel 280C3, and WCEH, 610 kHz, Hawkinsville, Georgia; WNNG, 1350 kHz, Warner Robins, Georgia; WNNG-FM, Channel 260A, Unadilla, Georgia; and the construction permit for a new FM facility on Channel 226A at Rochelle, Georgia.¹ There is contour overlap between the proposed WDXQ-FM and AM stations WNNG, WDCO and WCEH. While WNNG-FM is a metro station in the Macon, Georgia Arbitron Market and WNNG-FM, WSSY and WQXZ are considered "home" to the Macon, Georgia Arbitron Market, the proposed WDXQ-FM is not a metro station nor considered "home" in the Macon market. Therefore, an analysis using the revised contour overlap rules is necessary. A map of the city grade contours of these stations is attached as Exhibit #1.

NON-RATED MARKET REVIEW

2. A study has been conducted to determine if ownership of these facilities complies with §73.3555 of the Commission's rules. The contour of WNNG will be used to define

the market boundary, hereinafter referred to as the "Radio Market". The study will determine the number of other AM and FM stations that are contributors to the market. The number of contributors will then be added to the subject stations in the market to show the total number of stations in the market. Only those stations with transmitter sites within 92.0 kilometers will be considered as contributors to the subject markets. No other station in which GEB has an interest will be considered, unless it is a subject station in the market under review.

3. Exhibit #2 is a depiction of the stations within the Radio Market boundary. Exhibit #3 is a tabulation of the stations in the Radio Market, which totals ten stations when the four subject stations are included. The number of stations indicated fails in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules.² At this level, common ownership or control of up to five stations, with no more than three commercial stations in the same service, is permissible, provided the number of stations to be commonly held does not exceed 50% of the stations in the market.

4. Based on the compliance shown in the non-rated market, the minor change application for WDXQ-FM is in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules.

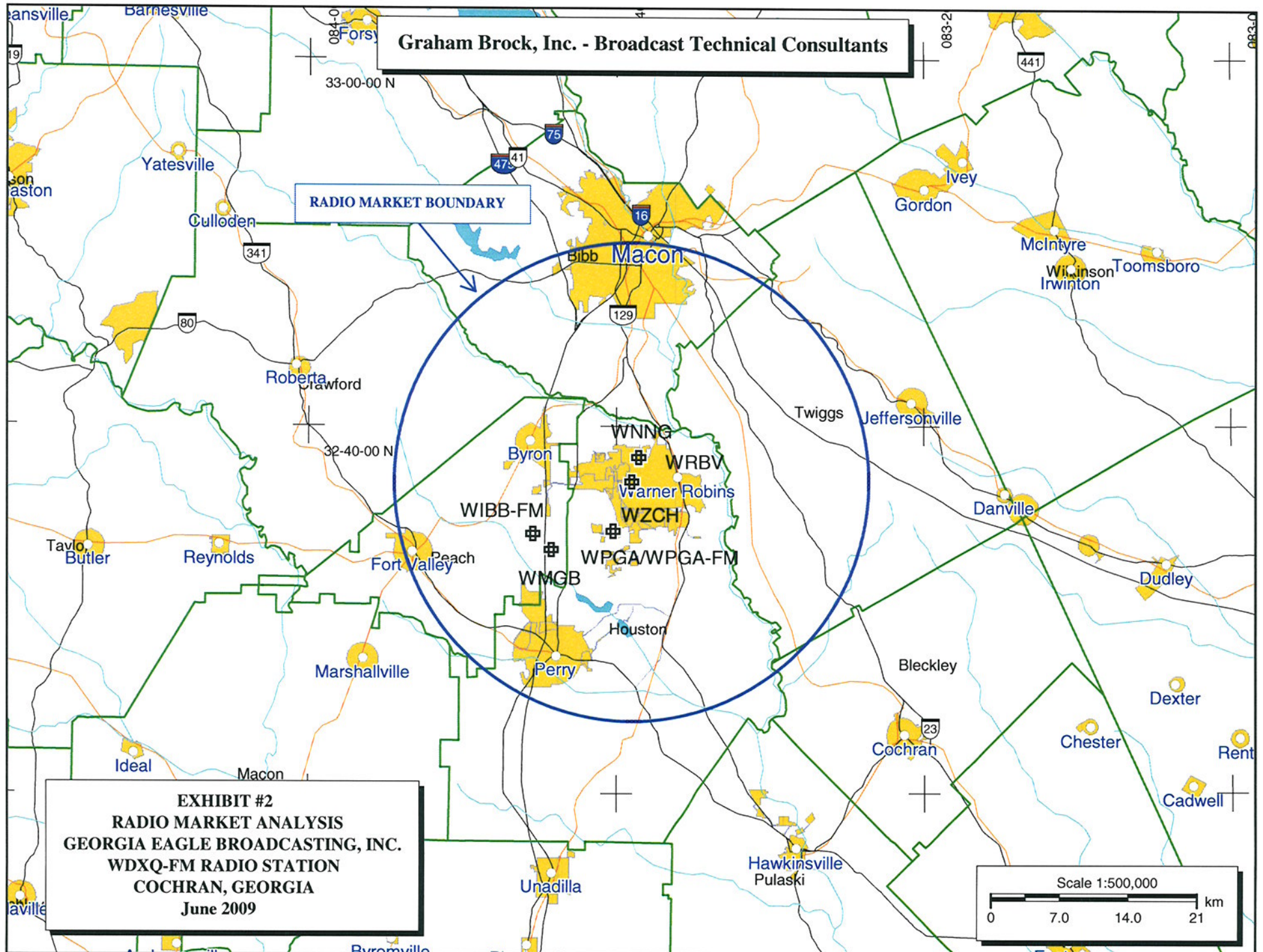

His qualifications are a matter of record before the Federal Communications Commission. He has been active in Broadcast Engineering since 1979.


