

Compliance with Section 73.3555(c)

The proposed assignee seeks to acquire Station WYDC(TV), Corning, New York, from WYDC, Inc., and six radio stations licensed to Sound Communications, LLC. In light of the September 23, 2019 decision, *Prometheus Radio Project*, 939 F.3d 567 (3rd Cir. 2019), *petition for rehearing en banc denied* (Nov. 20, 2019), which, *inter alia*, reinstated the radio/television cross-ownership rule, the proposed assignee must demonstrate that the common ownership of six radio stations and one full-power television station in the same market complies with Section 73.3555(c) of the Commission's rules.

In particular, the proposed assignee must demonstrate that there will remain 20 independent "voices" in the Corning-Elmira NY market post-merger. As provided below, after the proposed transaction is completed, there will remain more than 20 independent voices in the relevant market. Accordingly, the proposed transaction complies with the Commission's multiple ownership rules.
