

Response to Section II, Item 4 (b)

This application requests approval of a minor change in the facilities for WCMF-FM, (the “station”). Specifically the application proposes to relocate its antenna less than 1 kM from its present licensed location. This application does not seek to change the Station’s frequency or community of license, and it will not create new or increased concentration of ownership among commonly owned, operated or controlled media properties. Therefore, as explained below, the multiple ownership rules do not apply to this application.

The Multiple Ownership Rules Do Not Apply to Minor Change Applications that Do Not Involve a Change in Community of License or Create New or Increased Media Concentration.

This application is a “minor change” application because it does not propose a change in either the Station’s frequency or community of license. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 73.3573(a). Note 4 to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555 (2003) provides that multiple ownership rules apply only to applications for minor changes to existing stations that implement an approved change in an FM radio station’s community of license or created new or increased concentration of ownership among commonly owned, operated, or controlled media properties. Furthermore the grant of the application will not create any new or increased concentration of ownership. Therefore, multiple ownership rules do not apply to this application.
