
Per Section II, Item # 18 of this application, WAMC proposes a modification to an authorization that was awarded on the basis of a preference for fair distribution of service pursuant to Section 307(b) of the Communications Act, and the proposed modification will not downgrade service to the area on which the Section 307(b) preference was based.

WAMC applied for a new noncommercial educational FM station at Remsen, New York on August 7, 1997 in FCC File No. BPED-19970807MM. By letter decision dated October 6, 2005, DA 05-2384, the FCC named the WAMC Remsen application as the tentative selectee over the only other NCE FM station application in Group No. 970112, based on a decisive Section 307(b) preference.

Subsequent to the FCC's decision, WAMC filed an amendment to its Remsen new station application in April 2006, to specify a new site and modified facilities. As noted in the amendment, those modifications did not affect the decisive 307(b) preference. The modifications allowed WAMC to serve 100% of the coverage upon which the preference was based, and in fact added a significant amount of additional 60 dBu service beyond the contours considered for the 307(b) determination. The application was granted in August 2006, and the station is now authorized under call sign WRUN-FM.

WAMC now seeks to modify the permit for WRUN-FM, as needed to account for corrected tower orientation information. *See explanation in Exhibit 1.* As demonstrated by the attached map, the resulting 60 dBu contour will continue to encompass more than 100% of the 60 dBu contour and coverage of the original 1997 application, upon which the applicant's 307(b) preference was based. *Please see attached.*
