Reply to Deficiency Letter
And Request for Extension of Time

On behalf of WDLP Licensed Subsidiary, LLC, the licensee of W64AN and applicant for Channel 57 at Miami (“Applicant”), this replies to the August 15, 2005 Deficiency Letter (“FCC Letter”) and respectfully requests an extension of time to fully respond to the complex matters raised therein. In short, the FCC Letter asserts that the captioned application is predicted to cause interference to co-channel W57AM, Big Pine Key, FL and adjacent channel W58BU at Hallandale, FL. Although the Applicant believes that there are satisfactory answers and actions that can resolve these two interference issues,¹ the Licensee of W57AM has been unreachable for the last several weeks and the preparation of adequate technical documents by the Applicant’s consulting engineer, Dr. Byron St. Clair, has been unavoidably delayed because of Dr. St. Clair’s

¹ Dr. St. Clair, who is also engineering counsel to the Licensee of W57AM, has been unable recently to reach that licensee to obtain documentary evidence that it intends soon to build its displacement facility and, thus, to abandon W57AM, at Big Pine Key, FL; moreover, and in the alternative, the Applicant may amend the subject application to propose “offset” for channel 57 and to obtain a statement from the W57AM licensee that it is willing to accept any interference from the Applicant’s operation on channel 57. Likewise, the Applicant believes that interference to W58BU can be resolved, after confirming studies are finished, by reducing ERP in the direction of W58BU.

Accordingly, and for good cause shown, the Applicant respectfully requests a two-week extension to file a further response and, most likely, an amendment to the captioned application.
