Dear Mr. Moore:

This letter concerns your request, filed on November 8, 2010, on behalf of Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc., for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit FM Translator Station W291BQ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that W291BQ went silent on March 26, 2010, due to financial considerations. On March 26, 2010, Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc.'s requested an STA for the station to remain silent due to financial considerations. The STA was granted on May 13, 2010, and expired on November 12, 2010. Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc.'s, current request states that additional time is needed due to continued financial difficulties. Accordingly, Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc.'s requests that the STA be extended. Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc. request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.


Progressive Broadcasting System, Inc.'s request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W291BQ to remain silent until March 26, 2011. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for W291BQ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. on March 27, 2011.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
