Request for Special Temporary Authorization for Reduced Power Operation

NCE Station KSUI(FM), Iowa City, IA (Facility ID 66626)

Pursuant to Sections 73.1560(d) and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, The University of Iowa (the "University"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio Station KSUI(FM), Iowa City, Iowa, respectfully requests Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") for a period of three (3) months in order to maintain the station's current, temporary reduced power status for more than thirty (30) days.

The University previously notified the Commission that Station KSUI(FM) began operating at 50 % of its authorized power on October 5, 2011 due to technical issues beyond the University's control. Specifically, problems with the KSUI(FM) transmission line have necessitated the current reduced power operation. The University is currently awaiting replacement antenna line parts and is working to schedule a tower crew to implement the necessary repairs. As a result of the on-going repairs, it will be necessary for the station's reduced power status to extend for more than thirty (30) days.

A grant of reduced power STA will serve the public interest by allowing the University to maintain KSUI(FM)'s station's existing noncommercial educational radio operation and programming for listeners in the station's local community while it pursues the equipment repairs needed to restore full power service. The University is a noncommercial educational licensee and it operates KSUI(FM) on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the University qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
