

ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into this 9th day of August, 2005, by and between THE SISTER SHERRY LYNN FOUNDATION, INC. (hereafter the "Seller") and FAMILY WORSHIP CENTER CHURCH, INC. (hereafter the "Buyer"), for valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties do hereby agree, stipulate and contract as follows:

WHEREAS, Seller hold construction permits for a noncommercial FM broadcast Permits at Norman, Oklahoma, and a noncommercial FM broadcast Permits at Ada, Oklahoma from the Federal Communications Commission (hereafter "FCC") (hereafter the "Permits"); and

WHEREAS, Seller desires to sell to Buyer, and Buyer desires to acquire from Seller, the FCC Permits; and

WHEREAS, the Parties jointly understand that the proposed sale of the license for the Permits must be approved by the FCC prior to closing.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties wishing to be legally bound do hereby stipulate and agree to the following.

- I. **ASSETS TO BE SOLD.** Seller agrees to convey to Buyer all of its right, title and interest in the license for the Permits (as shown in Exhibit A hereto), validly in effect under the rules of the FCC. No assets will convey in connection with this transaction other than the Permits, since the Seller has not constructed either station and holds solely the Permits issued by the FCC.
- II. **PURCHASE PRICE AND TERMS.** The Buyer will pay the total sum of FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000.00). Buyer will place the \$50,000 of the purchase price in escrow with the Buyer's legal counsel, John C. Trent, upon the execution of this Agreement, and the funds will released to Seller on the closing date.
- III. **THE FCC APPLICATIONS.** Within 5 days after the execution of this Agreement, the Parties agree to cooperate with each other in the filing of an FCC assignment application (hereafter the "Assignment Application") seeking consent for the proposed sale of the Permits. The Parties agree to cooperate in supplying the FCC with all information it may require in connection with the FCC assignment application, which shall be filed by the Seller's counsel.

IV. REPRESENTATIONS OF SELLER. The Seller represents and warrants to Buyer that:

- a) Seller is legally qualified to execute this Agreement and there are no legal impediments to the execution of consummation of the transaction contemplated herein;
- b) Seller holds clear, unencumbered title to the Permits to be conveyed hereunder;
- c) The FCC Permits are in full force and effect and may be assigned to Buyer without any adverse conditions; and
- d) Seller knows of no reason that the contemplated transaction cannot be consummated as proposed herein.

V. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES OF BUYER. The Buyer hereby represents and warrants;

- a) Buyer is legally qualified to enter into this Agreement and consummate the transaction contemplated herein; and
- b) Buyer knows of no reason that the transaction contemplated herein may not be consummated.

VI. CLOSING. The closing on the sale shall take place five (5) days after the FCC has approved the assignment of the Permits to the Buyer without any conditions adverse to Buyer and that action has become a final order under the rules and regulations of the FCC; provided, however, that the Buyer has the right to close the transaction prior to a final order being in effect, in its sole discretion.

VII. DAMAGES. In the event Buyer shall breach its obligation to purchase the Permits under this Agreement, Seller shall receive damages in the amount of \$50,000.00 held in escrow by the Seller's counsel. In the event the Seller shall breach its obligation to sell the Permits, Buyer shall have the right to seek actual damages, or seek specific performance under the Agreement due to the unique nature of the assets to be acquired.

VIII. ASSUMPTION OF LIABILITIES. The Buyer shall not assume, or be responsible for, any of the liabilities or obligations of the Seller.

IX. EXCLUSIVE DEALINGS. The Seller agrees that for as long as this Agreement is in effect it will not discuss the sale of the Permits with any other person or party.

X. TERMINATION. This Agreement may be terminated by the Seller, in its sole discretion, if the transaction contemplated herein has not been

closed as of four months from the execution date and the funds in escrow will be returned to the Buyer.

XI. DELIVERIES AT THE CLOSING. At the closing, the Seller will deliver the following to the Buyer:

- a) A Bill of Sale for all the Permits; and
- b) Such other instruments as Buyer may reasonably request.

At the closing, the Buyer will deliver to the Seller the following:

- a) A release for the \$50,000.00 payment in escrow and the remainder of the \$450,000 of the purchase price, all to be wired to the Southmayd & Miller Escrow Account upon instructions from the Seller's counsel.

XII. SURVIVAL OF REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES.

The representations and warranties given herein shall survive the closing for a period of two years.

The Seller agrees to file such applications to modify the Permits as the Buyer shall desire to file with the FCC while the subsequent to the execution date hereof and while the assignment applications for the Permits are pending before the FCC. Buyer shall pay all expenses applicable to the filing of such applications by the Seller and shall provide Seller's counsel with all necessary components to such applications. The Closing hereunder shall not, however, be contingent or conditioned upon FCC approval of any such applications.

XV. BROKER. David F. Reeder of American Media Services - Brokerage, LLC is the exclusive broker on this transaction. The Buyer will pay the brokerage commission that is due to Mr. Reeder.

XVI. GOVERNING LAW. The laws of the United States of America and the State of Oklahoma will govern the interpretation of this Agreement.

XVII. COUNTERPARTS. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original copy of this Agreement and all of which, when taken together, will be deemed to constitute one and the same agreement.

WHEREFORE, the Parties have caused their signatures to be affixed to this Agreement intending to be legally bound.



It is hereby directed that, upon consummation, a copy of this consent be posted with the station authorization(s) as required by the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The assignee is not authorized to construct nor operate said station(s) unless and until notification of consummation in letter form has been forwarded to the Commission.
