The following technical exhibits and statement have been prepared on behalf of Okaloosa Public Radio, Inc. The purpose is to request a change in the recently issued construction permit. The original site proposed in 1997 is no longer available for use and a new site is proposed as well as an increase in station power (ERP). It is believed that this proposal is in full compliance with all applicable FCC rules.

47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 Showing:

Offered as exhibit 14 is a visual plot that clearly shows the city of Quincy, Florida will be totally encompassed with the proposed 60 dBu contour. Therefore, the provisions set forth in 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 are met.

Interference Concerns:

Offered as exhibit 16 is an interference study that shows compliance with 47 C.F.R. Section 73.509. This exhibit shows this proposal has full clearance with any existing or proposed facility. We recognize the proposed upgrades of WVFS and WANM, both filed in conjunction with this proposal.

Channel Six Protection:

Attached as exhibit 19 are letters that show concurrence with TV stations WCTV and WABW-DTV. Since the stations concur with this proposal, no detailed study is required or offered. This proposal is in full compliance with 47 C.F.R. Section 73.525.

RF Hazard Showing:

Attached as exhibit 22, is the RF Hazard calculation and statement. The applicant will construct new supporting structure. The SHOP and THPO issues are addressed in the attached statement. It is believed that this proposal is in full compliance with 47 C.F.R. Section 1.1306 of the Commission's Rules.
