

### **Revised Multiple Ownership Exhibit**

The proposed assignee SW Montana Media, LLC, a Montana limited liability company (“Assignee”), currently does not have any attributable or other interest in any other broadcast station or mass media. The Commission has previously approved ownership of the existing combination of five commercial radio broadcast stations licensed to Bozeman or Livingston, Montana (the “Bozeman Stations”), located in the Bozeman local radio market, that are being acquired by the proposed Assignee, which currently are all owned by the proposed assignor, Richard J. Samson, as Receiver. Attached with this exhibit is an engineering exhibit prepared by Mark A. Mueller (“Mueller”) that shows the relevant contours of the five stations and demonstrates, by the contour overlap method, that common ownership of the five stations continues to be permitted under the Commission’s radio multiple ownership rules.

As set forth in more detail in Exhibit 16 to this application, Assignee is 100% owned by Ted W. Austin, Jr. (“Austin”), who is also the Managing Member of Assignee; Austin has attributable interests in the following other AM or FM radio broadcast stations:

KJNT(AM), Jackson, Wyoming (Facility ID No. 161525)  
KANA(AM), Anaconda, Montana (Facility ID No. 668)  
KBOQ(FM), Lima, Montana (Facility ID No. 198810)  
KPCQ(AM), Chubbuck, Idaho (Facility ID No. 24627)  
KCHQ(FM), Soda Springs, Idaho (Facility ID No. 17436)

None of these stations in which the proposed Assignee or Austin hold an attributable interest are in the same local radio market as any of the five Bozeman Stations, or have principal community contours that overlap with the principal community contours of any of the five Bozeman Stations (as can be seen from Table 1 and Table 2 on page 2 of Mueller’s engineering exhibit, that lists all radio stations with contour overlap with the five stations being acquired), that Assignee requests Commission consent to acquire in this application:

KJNT(AM) is licensed to Jackson, Wyoming, which is its own local radio market, and is located more than 200 miles from any of the Bozeman Stations.

KANA(AM) is licensed to Anaconda, Montana, which is located more than 100 miles from any of the Bozeman Stations.

KBOQ(FM) is licensed to Lima, Montana, which is located well over 100 miles from any of the Bozeman Stations.

KPCQ(AM) is licensed to Chubbuck, Idaho, which is in the Pocatello, Idaho local radio market, and is located more than 200 miles from any of the Bozeman Stations.

KCHQ(FM) is licensed to Soda Springs, Idaho, which is located well more than 200 miles from any of the Bozeman Stations.

Therefore, the transaction and ownership of radio broadcast stations proposed in this application is in compliance with the Commission’s broadcast multiple ownership rules.
