

## Article Seven My Beneficiaries' Trusts

My Trustee shall administer and distribute my remaining trust property (not distributed under prior Articles of this instrument) under the terms of this Article.

### Section 7.01 Division of My Trust Property

My Trustee shall distribute my remaining trust property to the following beneficiaries:

Beneficiary	Relationship	Share
George E. Benko, Sr. and Ella F. Benko, or the survivor of them, otherwise <i>per stirpes</i> to their descendants	Parents	100%

My Trustee shall administer the share for each of my beneficiaries in a separate trust for the beneficiary's benefit as provided in the next Section.

### Section 7.02 Administration of Beneficiaries Trust

My Trustee shall administer the trust for each beneficiary as follows:

#### (a) Distributions of Income and Principal

My Trustee shall distribute to the beneficiary as much of the income and principal of the beneficiary's trust as my Trustee determines necessary or advisable for the health, education, maintenance and support of the beneficiary.

My Trustee shall add any undistributed net income to principal.

#### (b) Right to Withdraw Principal

At any time, the beneficiary may withdraw any portion or all of the accumulated trust income and principal from his or her trust.

The beneficiary may exercise this right by delivering written notice to my Trustee, setting forth the desired withdrawal amount. Upon receiving a notice, my Trustee shall convey and deliver the requested amount to the beneficiary, free of trust. This right of withdrawal is a privilege that may be exercised only by the beneficiary, and may not be subject to the claims of any creditor or to legal process and may not be voluntarily or involuntarily alienated or encumbered. This provision does not limit the beneficiary's exercise of any power of appointment the beneficiary may have.

**(c) Distribution upon the Death of the Beneficiary**

The beneficiary has the testamentary general power to appoint all or any portion of the principal and undistributed income remaining in the beneficiary's trust at the beneficiary's death among our descendants and charities qualified under Section 2055 of the Internal Revenue Code and the creditors of the beneficiary's estate. The beneficiary has the exclusive right to exercise this general power of appointment.

I intend to create a general power of appointment as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 2041.

If any part of the beneficiary's trust is not effectively appointed, my Trustee shall distribute the remaining unappointed balance *per stirpes* in trusts to the beneficiary's descendants. If the beneficiary has no then-living descendants, my Trustee shall distribute the balance of the trust property *pro rata* to the other beneficiaries under this Article.

If I have no then-living beneficiaries under this Article, my Trustee shall distribute the balance of the trust property as provided in Article Eight.

**Section 7.03 General Power of Appointment Over Property Subject to Taxable Generation-Skipping Transfers.**

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, any beneficiary of any separate trust created in this instrument has the unlimited testamentary general power to appoint to the creditors of the beneficiary's estate any property remaining in the trust for which a distribution would cause a taxable generation-skipping transfer in excess of any available generation-skipping transfer tax exemption, in the absence of the power of appointment. The beneficiary has the exclusive right to exercise this general power of appointment.

Any property in the trust that is not distributed under the exercise of the general power of appointment or is not subject to this power because it is not taxable as a generation-skipping transfer will be distributed under the provisions of the beneficiary's trust.

This provision applies to all trusts created for a beneficiary under this instrument and supersedes any contrary provisions, unless the provisions of a separate trust provide otherwise by reference to this provision.
