TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Family Broadcasting Group, Inc. ("FBG"), licensee of KXOC-LP, Channel 54+, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. FBG holds a permit to relocate KXOC-LP to a new channel (41Z) and site (BPTTL-20030715AAM). This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a calculation of the transmitter output power for the KXOC-LP transmitter.

There were two special operating condition/restriction listed on the KXOC-LP permit. The first relates to the use of a transmitter with a visual carrier tolerance of plus or minus 1.0 kHz. The KXOC-LP transmitter has the required tolerance. The second condition notes that KXOC-LP is a secondary service and must not cause interference to the reception of existing, or future, full service television stations and must accept interference from these facilities. FBG acknowledges this requirement.

FBG also notes it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of KXOC-LP or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that all conditions on the KXOC-LP permit have been satisfied.
