Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed January 17, 2012, on behalf of Entercom Greenville License, LLC ("Entercom"). Entercom requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on June 17, 2011, to operate Station WYRD with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, Entercom states that repairs were nearly complete when the station's antenna system again was damaged by vandals who removed the ground screens, copper straps and ground radials, as well as components in the antenna tuning units. Entercom states that it now will be necessary to engage an outside service to repair the ground system.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

<sup>1</sup> WYRD is licensed for operation on 1330 kHz with 5 kilowatts daytime and 5 kilowatts nighttime, employing a directional antenna during nighttime hours only (DA-N-U).

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYRD may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Entercom must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> Entercom must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **September 9, 2012**.
