**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Broadcast South, LLC. ("BSL"), licensee of station WVOH-FM, Channel 228C3, Hazlehurst, Georgia. BSL herein proposes to change the community of license of WVOH-FM from Hazlehurst, Georgia to Nicholls, Georgia, and upgrade to Channel 228C2, using the one-step application procedure, as outlined in MB Docket #05-210 (released November 29, 2006). In order to implement this change of community of license, BSL proposes to relocate WVOH-FM to a new site.

As BSL is proposing to implement this change of community of license at a new tower site, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") was apprised of this proposal. When the expected Determination of No Hazard is issued, the tower will be registered with the FCC and the Antenna Structure Registration Number will be provided to the Commission.

At the proposed WVOH-FM implementation site, Channel 228C2 does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to one other station. Therefore, a designated allocation reference site for Channel 228C2, which meets all of the Commission's

allocation criteria, has been identified (Exhibit A). At the WVOH-FM implementation site, the shortspace to the other FM facility is addressed pursuant to §73.215 of the rules (Exhibit B).

As indicated in Exhibit C, from a designated allocation site (different than the proposed implementation site), the proposed change of community of license from Hazlehurst, Georgia to Nicholls, Georgia for Channel 228C2 is mutually exclusive with the licensed WVOH-FM site; meets the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements; will deliver a signal over all of Nicholls, Georgia; and a review of the gain and loss of service areas shows this proposal is in the public interest. Therefore, this proposal meets the Commission's technical rules for a city of license change.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to BSL and is available to the Commission upon request.<sup>1</sup>
