Dear Ms. Dortch:

This letter concerns the minor change application BPED-20150715ABK (the “Application”) filed by Interlochen Center for the Arts on behalf of noncommercial educational FM station WHBP on July 15, 2015.

The Application requested FCC authorization to change WHBP’s broadcasting site and increase the station’s broadcasting power. On July 28, 2015, the FCC issued a letter to Interlochen’s counsel (the “Letter”) requesting that the Application be amended to include an FCC Antenna Structure Registration Number (“ASRN”) within 90 days. If Interlochen was unable to amend the Application within 90 days, the Letter required Interlochen to notify the Commission, in writing, and provide an update on the tower’s construction.

Interlochen is actively working with the tower’s owner, SBA Communications, towards completion of construction and the registration process of the new WHBP tower. Since the application was filed, numerous land impact and environmental surveys regarding the construction have been completed in order to ensure there was no adverse impact to a protected species located near the new tower site. Construction on the tower is expected to begin this fall and Interlochen is currently waiting for SBA Communications to complete the Antenna Structure Registration so that the Application can be amended to include the ASRN.



Interlochen will continue working with SBA Communications towards completing construction and obtaining an ASRN. Pursuant to the Letter, within the next 60 days Interlochen will either amend the Application to include the ASRN or submit another written report updating the Commission of the antenna structure registration process.
