TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Apex Broadcasting, Inc. ("Apex"), licensee of radio station KTSR, Channel 221C3, De Ridder, Louisiana. Apex also has an outstanding permit to relocate KTSR and implement a change in community of license to De Quincy, Louisiana (BPH-20031212AAY). This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a calculation of the transmitter output power for KTSR.

There are three special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the KTSR permit. The first relates to radio frequency radiation limits at the site. Apex herein restates that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of KTSR or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

The next condition notes that station KTSR must be returned to the air no later than July 16, 2005. Apex notes that KTSR is operating pursuant to automatic program test authority, thus KTSR has returned to the air and is no longer silent. The remaining condition states that a

license for KTSR on Channel 221C3 at De Quincy, Louisiana will not be granted until a license for non-commercial FM station KOJO, Channel 216C3, Lake Charles, Louisiana is granted.

Apex acknowledges this condition.

Based on the foregoing information, it is believed that all conditions on the KTSR permit have been satisfied.
