Request For Waiver Of The Main Studio Rule
Ozona, Texas

Christian Ministries of the Valley, Inc ("CMV"), the holder of a Commercial Educational FM Construction Permit for Facility ID 183369 Ozona, Texas, hereby requests a waiver of the Commission's main studio rule, 47 C.F.R. §73.1125. "CMV" requests permission to use the "CMV" main studio located 342.8 miles outside of the area allowed under the main studio rule.

"CMV" presently operates KRGE, Weslaco, TX from its main studio at 2720 W. Business Hwy 83, Weslaco, TX 78596.

The "CMV" main studio is located 367.8 miles Southwest of the center of Ozona, Texas, which is 342.8 miles outside of the area in which "CMV" could locate its main studio for Facility ID 183369 Ozona, Texas, under the main studio rule. "CMV" requests the office and studio be located at 2720 W. Business Hwy 83, Weslaco, TX 78596.

"CMV" would save considerable costs if the waiver were granted, rather than having to maintain separate main studios in the 25-mile area surrounding the center of Ozona. The total recurring cost savings annually is expected to be at a minimum \$84,800, based on the following:

Building Rent - \$1200 a month, \$14,400 a year

Employee's - \$10 x 2 = \$20hr x 40hrs wk = \$800, \$41,600 a year

Electric & Phones - \$650 a month, \$7,800 a year

Further, an immediate cost savings of \$21,000 is anticipated by removing the burden required in duplicating the studio equipment found at the main studio.

Editing & Programming Equipment - \$21,000

There will be no diminution in the "CMV" commitment to provide a programming service to meet the needs of Ozona residents if the Commission grants the waiver. To the contrary, a grant of the waiver will allow "CMV" to save the expense of maintaining separate main studios for Facility ID 183369, and thereby devote additional resources to serving Ozona with quality programming in the manner set forth herein.

With grant of this waiver, "CMV" commits to the following:

1. "CMV" will provide a toll free telephone line by which residents of the community can reach "CMV" management to express concerns about station operation. This action is taken consistent with Section 73.1125(c) of the Commissions rules.

2. "CMV" will establish a local advisory council to gather input on programming issues of interest to residents of the city of license by facility ID 183369 and to communicate that interest to management. Several residents within Ozona have committed to provide monthly feedback to ensure that the views of listeners are represented.

3. "CMV" will ascertain the needs of the facility ID 183369 listeners through an issue-oriented and interactive programming format, which relies upon direct community involvement in the form of listener calls. Further, We will undertake a quarterly survey of Ozona residents to gather their input regarding our programming.

4. "CMV" will provide local programming such as the weekly "Bulletin Board", which provides information about community events in the service area of the facility ID 183369 coverage area.

5. "CMV" will maintain a duplicate local public file for facility ID 183369 in Ozona with appropriate updates as required by §73.3527(e)(8)

In sum, "CMV" believes the grant of this waiver allowing operation of facility ID 183369 as requested, is an economically sensible way of meeting the community's demand for high-quality, commercial broadcasting while enabling "CMV" to best use its resources. Granting a waiver of the main studio rule in this case is fully consistent with the Commissions prior studio waiver grants for non-commercial entities including "CMV". The Commission will merely be extending to "CMV" authority to operate in a manner the Commission has previously determined serves the public interest.

For the foregoing reasons, "CMV" respectfully requests that the Commission grant this request for the waiver of the main studio rule.
