To Whom It May Concern:

You are listed in Federal Communications Commission (FCC) records as being the licensee of one or more Low Power Television stations (LPTV) and/or television Translator stations. As a result, you are being sent this notice. This notice pertains to operations in the 700 MHz frequency band only.

This letter serves as formal notification of the implementation of three public safety land mobile communications systems operating in the 700 MHz band. One is located in Bannock County, Idaho, another in Sandpoint, Idaho, and a third in Ada County, Idaho. By this letter, LPTV and Translator Stations are reminded that their operations are secondary to this primary public safety land mobile operation. Low power TV stations and TV translators may not cause interference to this public safety system and must accept any interference they might receive from these operations.¹

¹ The Report and Order on ET Docket No. 97-157 (FCC 97-421) for the "Reallocation of Television Channels 60-69, the 746-806 MHz Band," clearly defined Land Mobile operations as a "primary service" and that Low power TV and TV translator operations are secondary to all primary services in this band (see paragraphs 14 and 25-31).

PER OUR TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH BART HAMILTON, CHAIRPERSON ADA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, HE STATES THAT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THREE PUBLIC SAFETY LAND MOBLE COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS OPERATING IN THE 700MHZ BAND IS UNDERWAY, AND THAT ENGINEERING STUDIES ARE UNDERWAY FOR OUR (COUNTY) REGON 12, AND INDICATES THEY COULD IMPLEMENT THE EMERGENCY SYSTEMS BY MID SUMMER.

THIS REQUEST TO VACATE CHANNEL 61 (FREQUENCY 752-758MHz), IS TO PRECLUDE ANY AND ALL INTERFERENCE THAT WOULD BE POSSIBLE WITH THE IMPENDING EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS OPERATIONS.
