Dear Applicant:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807. Specifically, the site proposed is located 4.2 kilometers from the licensed facility for KAMM-FM (BLH-20071105AER) on Channel 268C1 in Frenchtown, MT. The required spacing pursuant to § 73.807 is 73 kilometers. The application fails to address this defect.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BPL-20170717ABB is unacceptable for filing and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.283 and 73.870(c).
