I am a Radio Engineer, an employee in the firm of Carl T. Jones Corporation, with offices located in Springfield, Virginia.

My education and experience are a matter of record with the Federal Communications Commission. I am a Registered Professional Engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia, Registration No. 027914.

GENERAL

This office has been authorized by Radio License Holding CBC, LLC (“RLHC”), licensee of AM Station KNEK, Washington, Louisiana, to prepare this statement in support of a request for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”). Station KNEK is licensed for operation on 1190 kilohertz with daytime power of 0.25 kilowatts using a non-directional antenna.

KNEK has been silent per an STA authorization FCC File No. BLSTA-20180212ABW, as extended by BLESTA-20180824AAH. KNEK requests to return to the air at a reduced power level of 0.03 kW daytime due to the inability, at this time, to



bring the transmitter back on at full power. RLHC requests an STA for a period of 180 days. Following repairs, or the replacement of a new transmitter and/or modules, the appropriate notification to the Commission will be made upon return to full authorized power.
