

TECHNICAL REPORT

This technical report is provided as analysis of the aural broadcast market formed by the modification of facilities for station WJMA-FM, Midlothian, VA as ordered in the Report & Order in MB Docket 03-47, RM 10592, released July 3, 2003. Pursuant to that order, WJMA-FM is to change its city of license from Orange to Midlothian Virginia and its channel from 255A to 255B1.

A plot of the city grade contour and channel study has been run by Laramie Guest of American Media Services, LLC and is submitted in this exhibit. The contour map demonstrates that, at its new location, WJMA-FM will not intersect with any other station owned by Joyner Communications, Inc. the proposed and approved assignee of WJMA-FM, or any of its principals. Accordingly, under both the methods of calculating a radio market, under the old §73.3555 or as required by the Commissions Report and Order in the 2002 Biennial Review of Broadcast Ownership Rules in MB Docket 02-277, the modification is in full compliance with the Commission's ownership rules.
