TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), licensee of FM translator station W265CB, Channel 265D, Toledo, Ohio. Cumulus has a construction permit (BPFT-20100429ADL) to make minor changes to the W265CB facilities. As a result of the minor change, the operating channel will be 264D and the call sign of the translator changes to W264AK. This new call sign will be referenced hereafter. Cumulus herein submits a license application to cover the outstanding permit. Attached as Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for FM translator W264AK.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W264AK permit. The first condition states that an application for license, FCC Form 350, must be on file prior to commencing program tests with the facilities authorized in the permit. The submission of this instant application satisfies the first condition.

The second condition states that Cumulus will reduce the power or cease operation of W264AK to insure that persons with access to the site are not exposed to radio frequency radiation levels above the FCC's guidelines. Cumulus states that it will, in cooperation with

other tower users, reduce the power or cease operation of W264AK, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed all conditions on the W264AK construction permit have been satisfied.
