

**Multiple Ownership
Compliance Study
CP BNPH-20060303ACA
Kahului, Hawaii
June 2006**

This multiple ownership Compliance Study was conducted to determine if Hochman Hawaii Three, Inc. can own Construction Permit BNPH-20060303ACA for a Class C2 FM station permitted to Kahului, Hawaii. Hochman Hawaii Three, Inc. is owned by George Hochman, 49%; Bill Poorman, 25.5% and William Mays, 25.5%. George Hochman and William Mays have an attributable interest in KONI Radio Station. Mr. Bill Poorman has no other broadcast interests in Hawaii.

William Mays and George Hochman also have an attributable interest in AM broadcast stations KORL and KRUD (CP). Exhibit one indicates that there is virtually no city grade overlap with the Kahului station that is the object of this Study. Please note that the KORL city grade signal brushes the western coast of the Island of Kahoolawe. This island is uninhabited. It was formerly used as a bombing site by the military. The island has no water supply. Because this island is uninhabited, the small city grade overlap is hereby disregarded just as city grade overlap over water is disregarded.

Exhibit 2 indicates the common area between KONI and the new Kahului CP. Only one radio market is formed by the addition of this CP to the commonly owned stations. Also illustrated in Exhibit 2 is the Subject Area studied in this report.


Exhibit 3 indicates some of the many services to the subject area. There were more services than the FM services listed here, but the additional services only go to further demonstrate the acceptability of this proposed acquisition. Exhibit 4 is a tabulation of the services to the Subject Area.

The Commission's Multiple Ownership Rule in Section 73.3555(a)(1)(iv) states:

(iv) In a radio market with 14 or fewer full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations, not more than 5 commercial radio stations in total and not more than 3 commercial stations in the same service (AM or FM); provided, however, that no person or single entity (or entities under common control) may have a cognizable interest in more than 50% of the full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations in such market unless the combination of stations comprises not more than one AM and one FM station.

The 7 stations identified here added to the two subject stations produces a total of 9 stations in the subject area. Owning two of nine stations is less than 50% of the radio services. Therefore the acquisition of Construction Permit BNPH-20060303ACA by Hochman Hawaii Three is allowable Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.

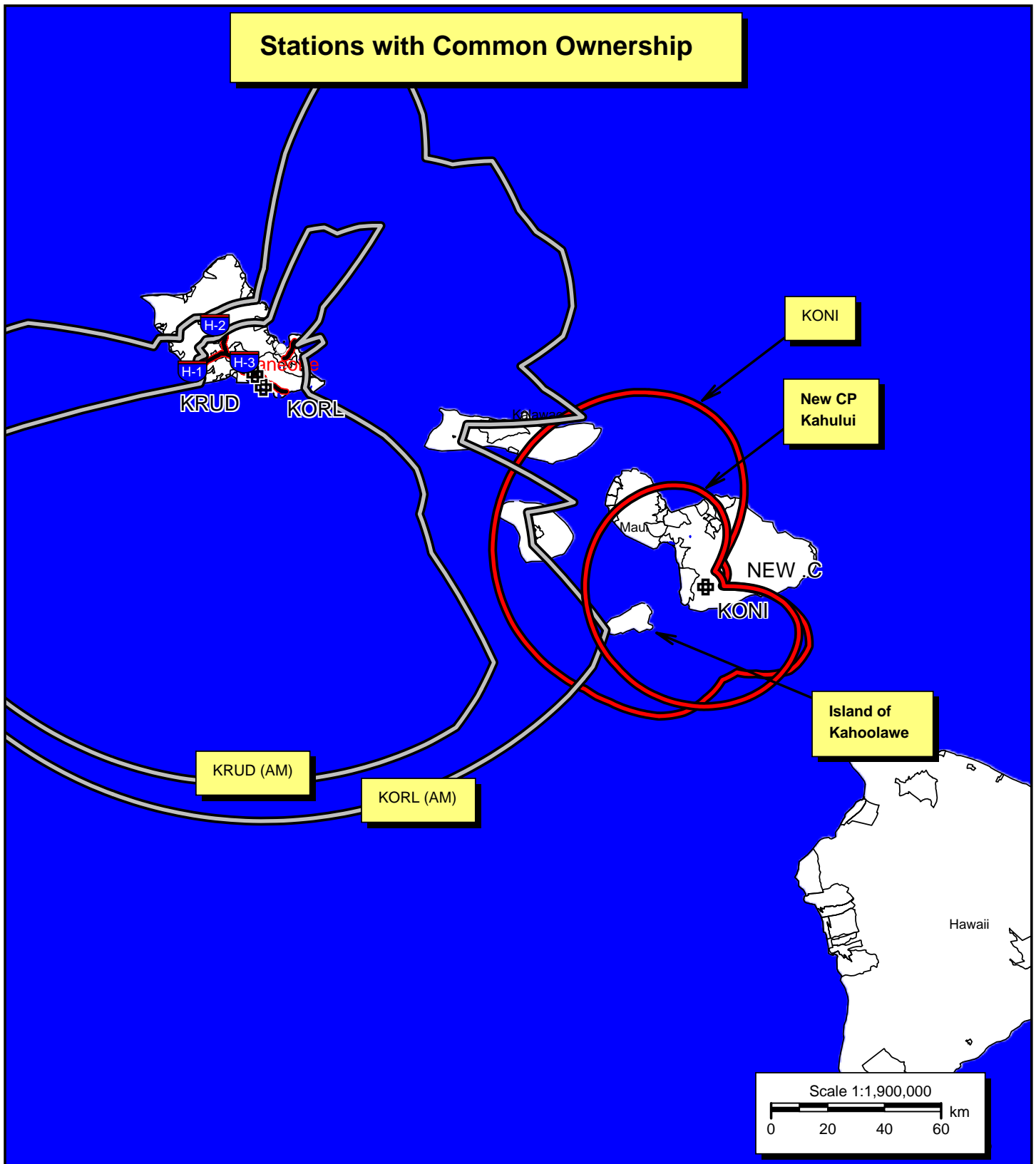


Exhibit 1

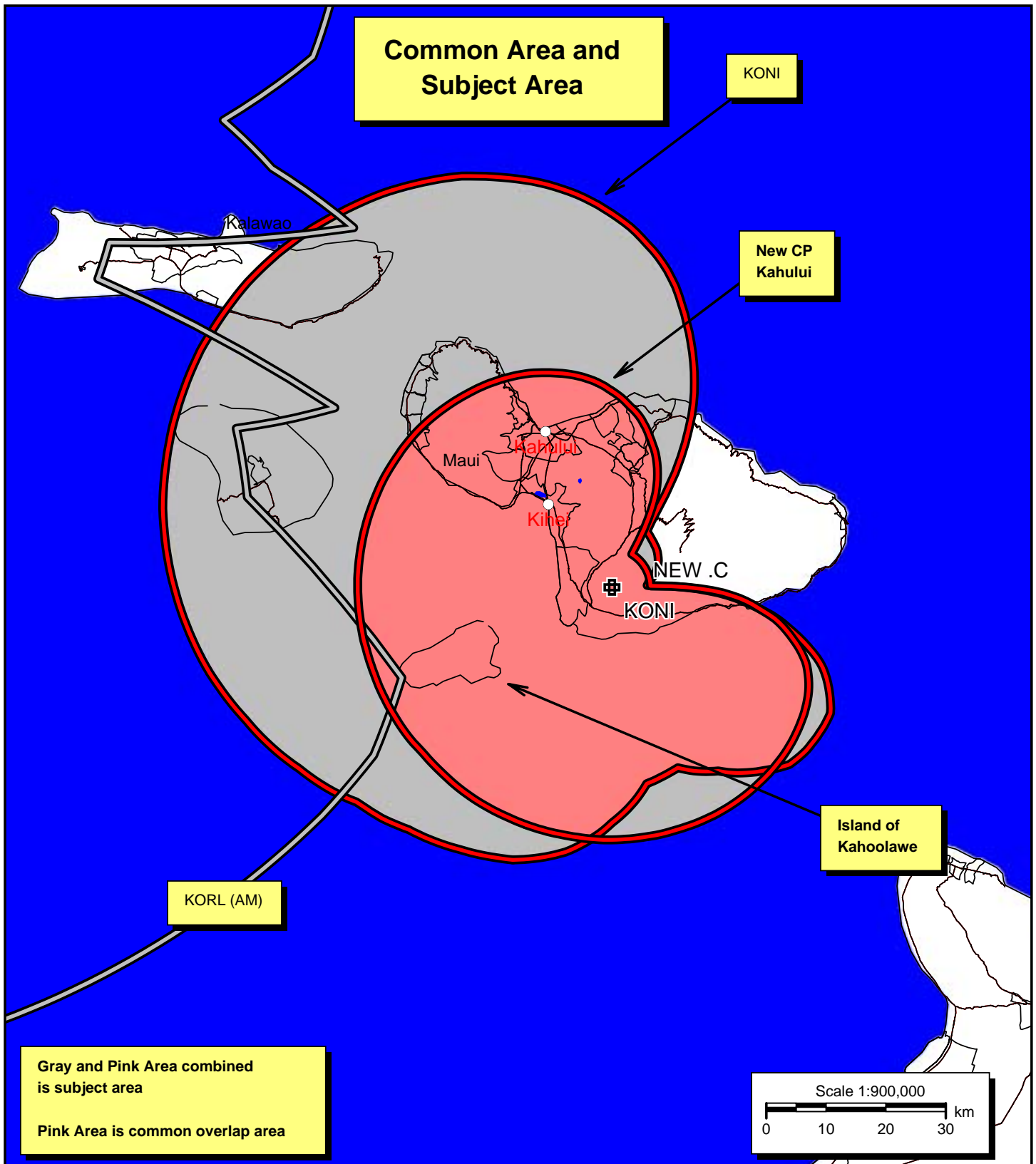

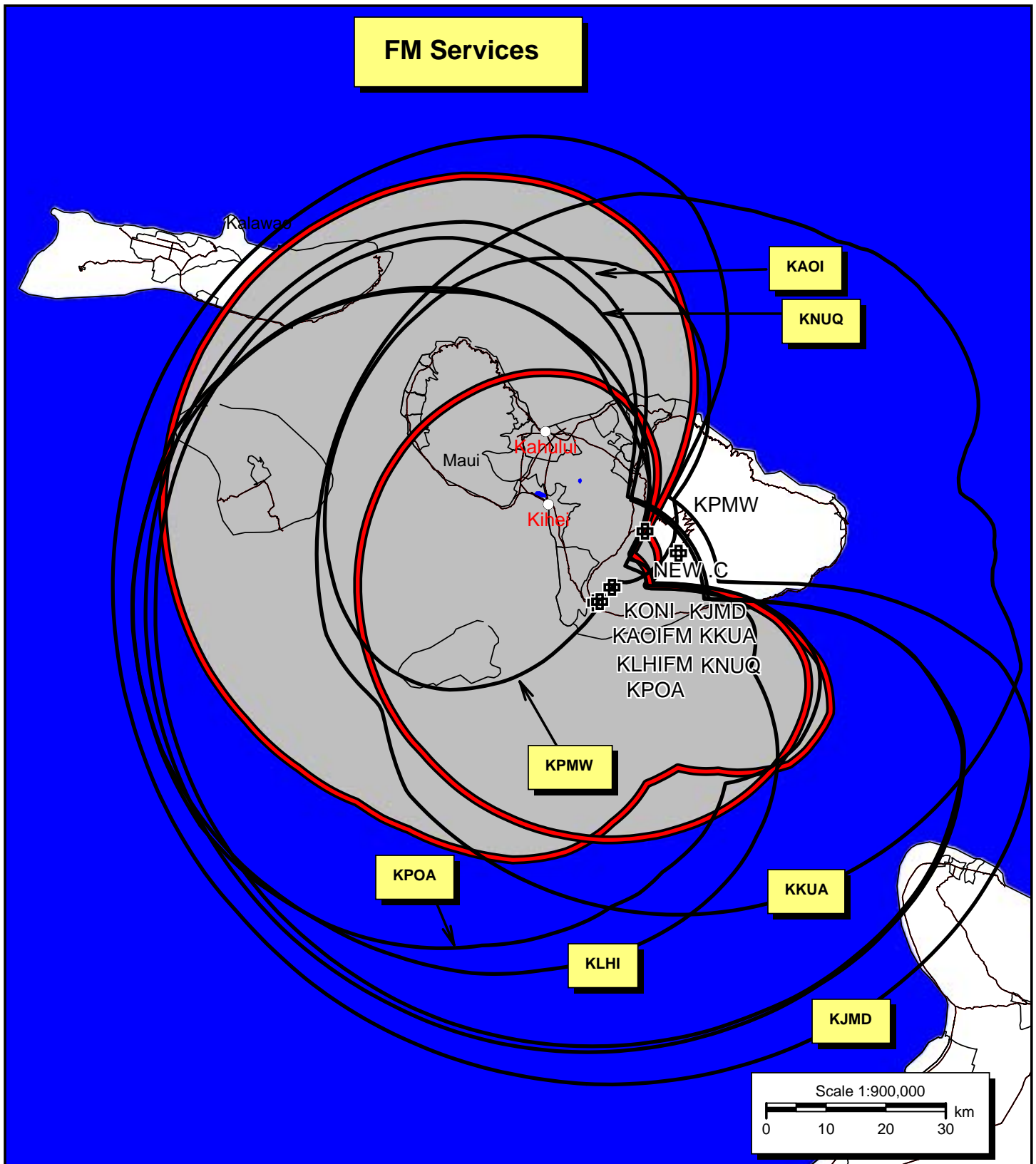
