

The Antenna farm on which the K265EZ system will be installed is a secure site with adequate signage to warn anyone of the dangers it has.

Starting at the bottom gate, a mile and a half from the transmitters, there is a secure gate that restricts vehicular traffic from the road.

#### Attachment 1

About a half mile above that gate, there is a second gate that is located on a ridge. It would prevent any motorized vehicle from passing and make it difficult for anyone on foot or bicycle.

#### Attachment 2

About a mile and a quarter above the bottom gate, there is a third gate to restrict access to the transmitter area located several hundred yards above that gate.

#### Attachment 3

Once the site is reached the buildings are clearly marked to warn anyone.

#### Attachment 4

The Tower on which the k265EZ antenna will be mounted is signed and fenced.
