Existence of Applicant

The applicant, a non-profit benevolent, religious and educational organization, is a Maine non-profit corporation, has been continuously located in Springvale, Maine since its incorporation by the Maine Secretary of State on December 7, 1970.

Our registered office of 22 Bridge Street, Springvale, Maine has approximate NAD27 coordinates 43° 21' 16" north latitude and 70° 28' 44" west longitude. The proposed transmitter and antenna location for our proposed low power FM station in the Sanford, Maine area would be at NAD27 coordinates 43° 25' 00" north latitude and 70° 48' 17" west longitude which is 3.488 miles away from our headquarters.

As we understand Section 73.853 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations, since the applicant's headquarters have been located within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for more than the past two years, the applicant qualifies as an "established local applicant" for purposes of the so-called point system. Additionally, all of the members of our governing board have resided within 20 miles of the proposed antenna location for more than the past two years.

Localism

As noted herein, we were incorporated in the state of Maine on December 7, 1970 and have been continuously located in Springvale, Maine since; at all times it has been in existence within 20 miles of the proposed transmitter and antenna site. Furthermore, all

Therefore, this application qualifies as an "established local applicant" pursuant to Section 73.853(b) of the FCC's Rules.
