

Hoak Media of Louisiana License, LLC (“Hoak”), licensee of commercial television station KNOE-TV, Facility ID No. 48975, Monroe, Louisiana (“KNOE”), respectfully submits the instant application (“Application”) seeking special temporary authority (“STA”) from the Commission to commence on February 16, 2009 early digital operations on KNOE’s post-transition digital television (“DTV”) channel in accordance with technical parameters specified in KNOE’s DTV construction permit, FCC File No. BPCDT-20080214ABZ (“DTV CP”). Such early commencement of digital operations is necessary to facilitate an orderly DTV transition in light of the uncertainty and potential for disruption caused by the current consideration by Congress of whether to significantly delay the DTV transition deadline.

The DTV CP includes a condition that the facility specified therein cannot commence operation prior to midnight on February 17, 2009 without the prior approval of the Commission. This Application is being filed to secure such approval in conformance with procedures established by the Commission.¹

As set forth in the Application, commencing operation of KNOE’s authorized post-transition DTV facilities on February 16, 2009 in accordance with its DTV CP will not cause impermissible interference with another television station and will enable KNOE to continue to serve its existing analog and pre-transition digital viewers for the remainder of the DTV transition.

Concurrently herewith, Hoak is filing with the Commission a notification of the termination of KNOE’s pre-transition DTV and analog television service as of February 16, 2009.
