Dear Dave:

I understand that Cooperative Television Association of Southern Minnesota ("CTV") plans to file the following applications for modification of facilities of its stations licensed to St. James, MN:

- (1) Flash-cut of Station K26CS (Facility ID 13844) to Channel 26-D
- (2) Minor modification (power increase) of Station K34JX-D (Facility ID 167237)
- (3) Flash-cut of Station K40BU (Facility ID 13847) to Channel 40-D
- (4) Flash-cut of Station K41IZ (Facility ID 13846) to Channel 41-D
- (5) Flash-cut of Station K44AD (Facility ID 13839) to Channel 44-D

I also understand that each of CTV's above-listed proposals is predicted to cause interference to the Federated Rural Electric Association ("FREA") authorization identified at the corresponding number below:

- (1) Construction Permit for analog K26IU (Facility ID 21286), a displacement CP for Station K53HR, Jackson, MN
- (2) Construction Permit K34JY-D, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 167628)
- (3) Licensed Station K40JN-D, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 167629)
- (4) Licensed Station K41EG, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 21287)
- (5) Construction Permit K44IV-D, Jackson, MN (Facility ID 167630)

Please be advised that in each of the five interference situations referenced above, FREA will accept interference from CTV's operations. You have FREA's permission to file a copy of this letter with the FCC in connection with CTV's application mentioned above.
