

**307(b) EXHIBIT**

Blue Chip Broadcasting Licenses, Ltd. (“BCBL”), the licensee of Stations WKSJ(FM), Urbana, Ohio, and WDHT(FM), Springfield, Ohio, submits this exhibit in support of two contemporaneously filed, contingent applications for modification of FM broadcast facilities. The first application (the “Enon Application”) proposes to delete Channel 269A at Urbana, Ohio; allot Channel 268A to Enon, Ohio as that community’s first local service; change the community of license for WKSJ(FM) from Urbana, Ohio to Enon, Ohio; and relocate the station’s transmitter site. *See* Enon Application, Exhibit 32, Technical Exhibit (the “Enon Technical Exhibit”) at 1, 4. The second application (the “Urbana Application”) proposes to delete Channel 275B at Springfield, Ohio; allot Channel 275B to Urbana, Ohio at the station’s current transmitter site; and change the community of license for WKSJ(FM) from Springfield, Ohio to Urbana, Ohio. *See* Urbana Application, Exhibit 32, Technical Exhibit (the “Urbana Technical Exhibit”) at 1, 3. BCBL’s showings pursuant to Section 307(b) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 307(b), are provided below, addressing the factors identified by the Commission in *Revision of Procedures Governing Amendments to FM Table of Allotments and Changes of Community of License in the Radio Broadcast Services*, Report and Order, MB Docket No. 05-210, FCC 06-163, ¶ 10 (rel. Nov. 29, 2006).

***The Enon Application***

As shown in the Enon Technical Exhibit, Channel 268A can be allotted to Enon, Ohio at the transmitter site proposed in the Enon Application consistent with Section 73.207 of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.207. *See* Enon Technical Exhibit at 1-2 and Figure 1. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Enon, Ohio from the proposed reference coordinates. *See id.* at Figure 2. The Station's proposed 70 dBu contour covers Enon, Ohio as well, in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.315. *See id.* at 2 and Figure 3. The relocation of station WKSJ(FM) from Urbana, Ohio to Enon, Ohio will result in a predicted net gain in population of 158,234 persons within the 60 dBu contour of the station. *See id.* at 5 and Figure 7, Sheet 1. The area and 2000 U.S. Census population within the Station's proposed 70 dBu contour are 559 km<sup>2</sup> and 183,058 persons, respectively. *See id.* at 5 and Figure 3. The area and 2000 U.S. Census population within the Station's proposed 60 dBu contour are 1,783 km<sup>2</sup> and 670,278 persons respectively. *See id.* The entire loss area will continue to receive at least 5 other aural services and will thus remain well served, except for a small portion (2000 U.S. Census population 232, area 13 km<sup>2</sup>), which will receive only 4 aural services. *See id.* at 6 and Figure 7. This proposal will not create any white or gray area. *See id.* Twenty three stations provide protected service to Enon. *See id.* at 6 and Figure 8.

BCBL desires to change the community of license for WKSJ(FM) from Urbana, Ohio to Enon, Ohio under the guidelines set forth in *Amendment of the Commission's Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License*, 4 FCC Rcd 3870 (1989), *recons. granted in part*, 5 FCC Rcd 7094 (1990) (the

“1989 Order”). There, the Commission stated that a station may change its community of license without subjecting the license to other expressions of interest if (1) the proposed allotment is mutually exclusive with the current allotment; (2) the current community of license will not be deprived of its only local service; and (3) the proposed arrangement of allotments is preferred under the Commission’s allotment priorities. These criteria are met here. First, the proposed use of Channel 268A at Enon, Ohio is mutually exclusive with the current use of Channel 269A at Urbana, Ohio. *See* Enon Technical Exhibit at 1-2 and Figure 1. Second, Urbana, Ohio will not be deprived of its only local service, due to the proposed change of the community of license of WDHT(FM) from Springfield, Ohio to Urbana, Ohio. *See id.* at 4. The proposed modification of WDHT(FM)’s community of license is discussed in greater detail below. Finally, upon grant of both the Enon Application and the Urbana Application, Enon, Ohio will gain a first local service, while the number of local services for Springfield, Ohio will be reduced from five to four. *See id.* Thus, provision of a first local service at Enon, Ohio (2000 U.S. Census population 2,638) under Priority 3 will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments over the retention of a fifth local service at Springfield, Ohio (2000 U.S. Census population 65,358) under Priority 4. *See id.*; Urbana Technical Exhibit at 4; Attachment A; Attachment B; *Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1982) (the “1982 Order”).

The majority of Enon is located within the Dayton, Ohio Urbanized Area. *See* Enon Technical Exhibit at 5 and Figure 6. Therefore, this relocation implicates the Commission’s policy regarding the migration of stations into urban areas. *See Headland*,

*Alabama and Chattahoochee, Florida*, 10 FCC Rcd 10352 (1995) (“*Headland*”); *Faye and Richard Tuck*, 3 FCC Rcd 5374 (1988) (“*Tuck*”). In making the determination whether to award an urbanized community a first local service preference, the Commission will consider (1) the extent to which the station will provide service to the entire Urbanized Area, (2) the relative populations and proximity of the suburban and central city, and, most importantly, (3) the independence of the suburban community. *Tuck*, 3 FCC Rcd at 5377-78.

The proposed 70 dBu contour of WKSX(FM) will cover 27% of the Dayton, Ohio Urbanized Area. *See* Enon Technical Exhibit at 5 and Figure 6. The proposed 70 dBu contour for the allotment reference coordinates will cover 2% of the Dayton, Ohio Urbanized Area. *See id.* Enon’s population (2000 U.S. Census 2,638) is less than 2 percent of the population of Dayton (2000 U.S. Census 132,679). *See* Enon Technical Exhibit at 4; Attachment A; Attachment B. Based on measurement tools available on the FCC’s Internet site, Enon is located approximately 16 miles from Dayton. These figures demonstrate independence and are comparable to those of other suburban communities granted a first local preference. *See e.g., Talladega and Munford, Alabama*, 20 FCC Rcd 13010, 13012 (2005) (Munford’s population is 10% of that of Anniston, and Munford is located 11.3 miles from Anniston); *Park City, Montana*, 19 FCC Rcd 2092, 2094 (2004) (Park City’s population is less than 1% of that of Billings, and Park City is located 21 miles from Billings); *Ada, Newcastle and Watonga, Oklahoma*, 11 FCC Rcd 16896, 16899 (1996) (Newcastle’s population is less than 1% of that of Oklahoma City, and Newcastle is located 15 miles from Oklahoma City).

Nevertheless, the Commission has repeatedly stated that these factors are less important than evidence of independence. *See Headland*, 10 FCC Rcd at 10355. The following analysis shows that, pursuant to the eight *Tuck* factors, Enon, Ohio is independent from Dayton, Ohio. *See, e.g., Parker and St. Joe, Florida*, 11 FCC Rcd 1095 (1996); *Jupiter and Hobe Sound, Florida*, 12 FCC Rcd 3570 (1997).

(1) *The extent to which the community residents work in the larger metropolitan area, rather than the specified community:* Enon residents can work in any of the many businesses located within or just outside the Village limits. For example, Enon is the headquarters of the Speedway SuperAmerica gas station chain, and numerous other businesses are located both within and just outside of the Village limits. *See* Attachment B; Attachment C. The businesses inside Enon itself include restaurants, salons, a video store, a cleaners, insurance offices, auto repair and sales shops, medical offices, pet care facilities, financial businesses, a gas station, and various other commercial and service establishments. *See id.* Indeed, Enon’s website lists more than fifty businesses located within Enon and approximately 25 businesses outside the Village that serve Enon’s residents. There is an Enon Area Business Association as well. *See* Attachment E. Approximately 8% of Enon’s residents work in Enon. *See* Attachment B.

(2) *Whether the smaller community has its own newspaper or other media that covers the community's needs and interests:* Enon has its own weekly newspaper – *The Enon Messenger* – published by Times Community Newspapers. *See* Attachment D; Attachment E. *The Enon Messenger* is dedicated to providing Enon with “local news and

feature stories about people, events, schools, businesses, sports, and government, with particular emphasis on the impact of local government decisions on ... readers.” *See id.*

(3) *Whether community leaders and residents perceive the specified community as being an integral part of, or separate from, the larger metropolitan area:*

Enon is distinct from the Dayton metropolitan area. Three Native American groups made their homes in the Enon before the arrival of the first European settlers – the Adena, the Hopewells, and the Shawnees. *See Attachment C.* Due to this heritage, Enon is home Ohio’s second largest conical Native American burial mound. *See Attachment B; Attachment F.* Enon was a large agricultural center from 1817 to 1838, was platted in 1838, and was incorporated in 1850. *See Attachment C.* Today, Enon is the principal village in Mad River Township, Clark County, Ohio, and is “[p]roud of over 150 years of prosperity and heritage” *See id.*

The Enon Community Historical Society, which is located just behind the Village Government Building, is dedicated to preserving Enon’s independent heritage and spirit through events, services and projects. *See Attachment F.* For example, Enon’s annual Apple Butter Festival hosts community organizations; crafts, foods, arts, and entertainment chosen by Enon residents; and demonstrations of old-fashioned apple butter making. *See id.* The society works to restore and preserve both Enon’s Native American Burial Mound and one of Enon’s earliest homes – a log structure dating to the 1830s. *See id.* And, the society maintains an extensive genealogy library, historical books about Enon, special collection exhibits, audiovisual documentation, and similar materials concerning the history and heritage of Enon. *See id.*

(4) *Whether the specified community has its own local government and elected officials:* Enon's local government is housed in the Enon Government Center, which is located in the village itself. *See* Attachment C. The Enon Village Staff includes a Village Mayor, Village Administrator, Water Treatment Plant Operator, and Village Secretary / Clerk of Court. *See id.* Enon's Village Council consists of a Clerk, a Council President, and five additional members. *See id.* Enon has its own police, water, and zoning departments, as well as a Fire Department/EMS. *See id.*; Attachment G. Enon's Mayor's Court hears "cases involving violations of local ordinances and state traffic laws" *See* Attachment C; Attachment H. Enon's local government also manages the Village's two public parks. *See* Attachment C.

(5) *Whether the smaller community has its own local telephone book provided by the local telephone company or zip code:* Enon has its own post office and zip code (45323). *See* Attachment C; Attachment I. Enon's website, as well as other Internet sources, provide links to businesses and organizations in Enon. *See, e.g.,* Attachment C; Attachment J.

(6) *Whether the community has its own commercial establishments, health facilities, and transportation systems:* There are numerous commercial establishments in and around Enon, Ohio, including (but not limited to) Enon Auction House, Enon Auto Sales, Enon Auto Service, Enon Drive Thru, Enon Mini Warehouse, Enon Pet Grooming, and Enon Veterinary Clinic. *See* Attachment C. There is an optometrist in Enon, as well as a health facility devoted to cardiac care. *See* Attachment C; Attachment K; Attachment L.

(7) *The extent to which the specified community and central city are part of the same advertising market:* Enon has its own advertising market. For example, businesses, organizations, and other advertisers wishing to reach Enon's residence can advertise in *The Enon Messenger* – Enon's weekly newspaper – which has both print and Internet versions. See Attachment E. Advertisers can also use [www.enonohio.net](http://www.enonohio.net), which specifically targets Enon. See Attachment J.

(8) *The extent to which the specified community relies on the larger metropolitan area for various municipal services such as police, fire protection, schools, and libraries:* Enon is highly self-reliant community. Enon has a water treatment plant, a police department, a fire department/EMS, two local parks, a post office, a library, a middle school, and an elementary school. See Attachment C; Attachment G; Attachment I. Enon is home to a child care center as well. See Attachment M. There are numerous community organizations in Enon, such as the Enon Lion and Lioness Clubs, Enon Relief (a local, all-volunteer service organization comprised of members from Enon's churches and community groups), Keenagers (an Enon organization of senior citizens that enjoy entertainment, short trips, and fellowship), and local sports leagues. See Attachment C; Attachment N; Attachment O. Enon is also home to five churches. See Attachment J.

### ***The Urbana Application***

BCBL also desires to change the community of license for WDHT(FM) from Springfield, Ohio to Urbana, Ohio under the guidelines set forth in the *1989 Order*.

As demonstrated in the Urbana Technical Exhibit, Channel 275B can be allotted to Urbana, Ohio at the Station's current transmitter site consistent with Section 73.207 of the FCC's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 73.207. *See* Urbana Technical Exhibit at 2 and Figure 2. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Urbana, Ohio from the proposed reference coordinates. The Station's 70 dBu contour covers Urbana, Ohio as well, in compliance with 47 C.F.R. § 73.315. *See id.* at 1-2 and Figure 2. The area and 2000 U.S. Census population within the Station's 70 dBu contour are 3,352 km<sup>2</sup> and 581,734 persons, respectively. *See id.* at 5 and Figure 1. The area and 2000 U.S. Census population within the Station's 60 dBu contour are 8,530 km<sup>2</sup> and 1,115,997 persons respectively. *See id.* Thirteen stations provide protected service to Urbana. *See id.* at 5 and Figure 4. Because the Urbana Application does not propose a change in transmitter site, no gain or loss areas are created by the proposal. *See id.* at 4.

The relocation proposed in the Urbana Application meets the relevant criteria from the *1989 Order* as well. First, the proposed use of Channel 275B at Urbana, Ohio is mutually exclusive with the current use of Channel 275B at Springfield, Ohio. *See id.* at Figure 2. Second, after the relocation, Springfield, Ohio will continue to be served by four stations: WEEC(FM), WIZE(AM), WULM(AM), and WUSO(FM). *See id.* at 4; Enon Technical Exhibit at 4. Finally, as discussed above, provision of a first local service at Enon, Ohio (2000 U.S. Census population 2,638) under Priority 3 will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments over the retention of a fifth local service at Springfield, Ohio (2000 U.S. Census population 65,358) under Priority 4. *See id.*; Urbana Technical Exhibit at 4; Attachment A; Attachment B; *1982 Order*. As it is

presently the community of license of WKSJ(FM), the proposed community of Urbana, Ohio has already demonstrated, to the Commission's satisfaction, that it is a community deserving of local radio service.

Enon is located at 39°52′13″N, 83°56′4″W﻿ (http://tools.wikimedia.de/~magnus/geo/geohack.php?params=39\_52\_13\_N\_83\_56\_4\_W\_city) (39.870309, -83.934462<sup>GR1</sup>). The village sits roughly 3 miles south of the old National Road.

According to the United States Census Bureau, the village has a total area of 3.4 km<sup>2</sup> (1.3 mi<sup>2</sup>), all land.

## Demographics

As of the census<sup>GR2</sup> of 2000, there were 2,638 people, 1,118 households, and 799 families residing in the village. The population density was 765.8/km<sup>2</sup> (1,989.6/mi<sup>2</sup>). There were 1,157 housing units at an average density of 335.9/km<sup>2</sup> (872.6/mi<sup>2</sup>). The racial makeup of the village was 97.01% White, 0.57% African American, 0.30% Native American, 0.61% Asian, 0.27% from other races, and 1.25% from two or more races. Hispanic or Latino of any race were 1.02% of the population.

There were 1,118 households out of which 26.4% had children under the age of 18 living with them, 61.4% were married couples living together, 7.3% had a female householder with no husband present, and 28.5% were non-families. 25.6% of all households were made up of individuals and 10.2% had someone living alone who was 65 years of age or older. The average household size was 2.36 and the average

family size was 2.82.

In the village the population was spread out with 20.5% under the age of 18, 7.0% from 18 to 24, 23.3% from 25 to 44, 32.8% from 45 to 64, and 16.4% who were 65 years of age or older. The median age was 44 years. For every 100 females there were 97.9 males. For every 100 females age 18 and over, there were 96.0 males.

The median income for a household in the village was \$58,966, and the median income for a family was \$69,196. Males had a median income of \$45,335 versus \$28,872 for females. The per capita income for the village was \$29,537. About 2.4% of families and 2.8% of the population were below the poverty line, including 3.8% of those under age 18 and 1.8% of those age 65 or over.

**ENON**

Enon, the principal village in Mad River Township, Clark County, Ohio, is located on the old Springfield and Dayton Turnpike, seven and one-half miles southwest of Springfield. The village was also located on an Indian trail which ran between the Indian Villages of Old Piqua and Old Chillicothe.

Three distinct groups of Indians made their homes in the Enon area prior to the coming of the first white settlers. First to make their homes here were the Adena. Second were the Hopewells, as evidenced by excavations of the Campbell mounds. Last were the Shawnees who lived at Old Piqua, where George Rogers Clark Park is now located.



The first settlers in Mad River Township settled sometime prior to 1798. The name Enon means "abundance of springs" and from 1817 to 1838 the area was a flourishing agricultural center. On May 19, 1838, the site of Enon was platted by Ezra Baker and Elnathan Corey and lots one through 60 were approved June 18, 1838. The town of Enon was dedicated at the time the Springfield and Dayton Road was laid out. Finally on March 15, 1850, Enon was incorporated.

## Regulations

- **Accessory Building**

No detached accessory building shall be erected in any required yard or court, except a rear yard, and shall not occupy more than thirty five percent (35%) of the area of the required rear yard.

A detached accessory building shall not exceed one story or fourteen feet in height in any "R", "O" or "B-1" District.

Detached accessory building shall be at least six feet from the side and/or rear lot lines.

- **Fences Around Swimming Pools**

Effective March 10, 1998, no person shall construct, install, or enlarge a residential swimming pool not enclosed in a permanent building unless the pool is completely enclosed by a fence of sufficient strength to prevent access to pool. Gates or doors shall be equipped with self-closing and self-latching devices for keeping the gate or door securely closed at all times when not in actual use.

- **Garage Sale Signs**

Enon Village Ordinance states...No signs shall be erected, attached or otherwise applied to trees, utility poles, fences, other natural features, or any other unapproved supporting structure in the public right-of-way.

- **Fences**

Fences typically do not require a zoning permit in the Village of Enon. However, in certain circumstances a permit is issued. Please contact the Zoning Department before installation.

No fence, wall, shrubbery, sign or other obstruction to vision above a height of two feet from the established street grades shall be permitted within the triangular area formed at the intersection of any street right-of-way lines by a straight line drawn between such right-of-way lines at a distance along each line of twenty five feet from their point of intersection.

A fence, wall, hedge, or shrubbery may be erected, placed, maintained, or grown along a lot line in a Residential District or adjacent thereto to a height not exceeding eight feet above the ground level, except that no such fence, wall hedge, or shrubbery which is located in a required front or corner side yard shall exceed a height of three and one-half feet and shall be subject to the traffic visibility requirement of Section 1165.02 for a corner lot.

Recorded lots having a lot area in excess of two acres and a frontage of at least 200 feet, and acreage or parcels not included within the boundaries of a recorded plat in all residential districts, are excluded from these fence regulations. (Ord. 74-8 Passed 10-3-74)



### **Enon Skateboard Park Rules**

Safety Equipment Requirements – The minimum safety equipment recommended at this facility includes: protective helmets, elbow pads, knee pads, wrist guards. All parents should require their children to wear this protective equipment while using the facility. Failure to wear protective equipment will expose users to bone fracture, concussion and other serious or fatal injury upon falling or collision with other users.

### **General Rules:**

- Skating is restricted to the skating area;
- No glass containers, food, gum or beverages allowed on the skating surface;
- No other items such as benches, tables, wood materials, or other objects used as ramps or jumps are allowed in the skate park facility;
- No pets are allowed in skate park area;
- No skating against traffic on ramps or pipes;
- Do not proceed down ramp until clear of other skaters;
- Alcohol, tobacco, drugs and weapons are prohibited;
- Horseplay, roughhousing, fighting, violence, and profanity are prohibited;
- No bicycle or scooter usage in skate park area;



## **Ohio Mayor's Courts**

Ohio law allows mayors of municipal corporations populated by more than 100 people that have no municipal court to conduct mayor's court. These courts, which are not courts of record, hear only cases involving violations of local ordinances and state traffic laws. Those convicted in a mayor's court may appeal their conviction to the municipal or county court having jurisdiction within the municipal corporation. Ohio law does not require mayors hearing cases to be attorneys.

Section 1905.033 of the Ohio Revised Code, effective Jan. 1, 2004, requires mayor's courts to register annually and file statistics quarterly with the Supreme Court of Ohio. At the request of the Ohio General Assembly, the Supreme Court of Ohio adopted rules providing for court procedures and basic legal education for mayors hearing cases. Furthermore, mayors whose courts hear alcohol and drug-related traffic offenses have additional educational requirements.

Dr. Ernst Fischer once dreamt of being a musician. That is, until his father insisted he become an optometrist instead.

"My dad was from Germany and he was a very tenacious fellow," says Ernst. "He said I had to become an optometrist and so I did." Luckily, close to 40 years later, Dr. Fischer, who retains his love of the arts, is enjoying being an optometrist and owns his own practice in Enon, Ohio.

"It was important to me to have my own practice. My first office was literally a 'hole in the wall.' Once I expanded my practice, I built a new building in 1975, and I've been there ever since," he says.

Specializing in the area of vision analysis, Dr. Fischer primarily treats children and adults who have neurological damage, and works to optimize their often-neglected visual motor capabilities. He's a member of an elite group of optometrists that belong to the Neuro-Optometric Rehabilitation Association (NORA).

"It takes me about 2 ½ hours to do an eye exam. I try to determine if their behavior is related to vision difficulties," he says. "I'm usually the last resort after children have been seen by psychologists, occupational or physical therapists."

Dr. Fischer has been part of the VSP network since he became an optometrist. "I only see VSP and Medicare patients," he says. "VSP treats me well, it works easily and my patients seem very satisfied with their benefits."

In his free time, you'll find Dr. Fischer playing the saxophone, clarinet or flute in one of eight bands. "Music is my first love and many of my patients are musicians, artists and psychologists."
