

Wayne,

For your records, we never held the license for that little channel 2 at Allison. Neither Ruben nor I have visited the site. We have no record of ever owning the equipment and, since we have never been there, it's unlikely that we "took it out".

Sometimes we have equipment mailed to us for repair, but we have no channel 2 equipment in the shop, at all.

I overheard Freddy Bragg (former DOE, here) having a conversation with someone up there who suggested that we "take over" the translator and its maintenance. We never agreed to do so and have no intention of purchasing or installing equipment at/for the site, at this time.

We do not intend to activate K02HM or seek to acquire the license. If K02HM were to be activated, I'm afraid it would have to be the license holder doing it.

No interference from here!
