Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 3, 2016. CCL requests an extension of the STA granted on November 5, 2015, to operate station WHYN(AM) using tower #2, due to the replacement of guy wires and top-loading, followed by the required filing of an FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters.¹ In support of the request, CCL states that a new tower crew has been scheduled to properly complete all required work.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for an extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WHYN(AM) may continue to operate ND using tower #2 (ASRN 1003894) per Section

¹ WHYN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 560 kHz with 5 kW day and 1 kW night.

73.1680 using a maximum power of 1.25 kW (daytime) and 0.25 kW (nighttime) when the tower work is being done, or with parameters at variance using reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed tolerances at all other times. It will be necessary to further reduce or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.13 10. A final STA extension request must be filed before the expiration date shown below if the FCC Form 302 application remains pending.

This authority expires on **November 23, 2016**.
