Petition for Reconsideration

North Austin Community Media hereby seeks reconsideration of the action by staff dismissing the above captioned application. This application was part of LPFM MX Group #334 and was dismissed as the newest organization in a tie breaker. This request is timely, being within 30 days of the public notice which was on 03/31/2015.

The applicant has amended its application by specifying a different channel of operation and transmitter site. The change is a “minor modification” which is allowed outside of a window, because it moves to a first-adjacent channel and is within the required distance from the original site. The proposed new site meets all separation requirements spelled out in 47 CFR 73.807 as regards other co-channel and first-adjacent stations and meets the requirements spelled out in 47CFR 73.807(E) permitting a waiver of second-channel adjacent spacing requirements with regards to KLBJ-FM, Austin, Texas.

Reinstatement of the application, as amended, will result in a singleton application, which might be granted immediately, providing new service to the public which might not otherwise occur. No other party would be prejudiced by reconsideration.

For the reasons stated, the applicant respectfully requests that reconsideration be granted and the application be reinstated *nunc pro tunc*.
