TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Legend Communications of Wyoming, LLC (“Legend”), licensee of KLGT, Channel 225C1, Buffalo, Wyoming. Legend is proposing to make minor changes in the facilities of KLGT by slightly relocating the station and increasing the antenna height above ground, above mean sea level and above average terrain. No other changes are proposed. It is noted that this proposed site is only 0.23 kilometer (754 feet) from the licensed KLGT facilities.

Since a new tower is proposed for KLGT, the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) has been apprised of this correction. Once the FAA issues its Determination of No Hazard, the tower will be registered with the Commission.

It is noted that Legend is proposing to install the KLGT antenna on a short tower on which another FM station will be co-located.¹ As such the RFR worksheets associated with FCC Form 301 could not be used to verify this proposal meets the Commission’s Radio

1) An application to relocate station KZZS, Story, Wyoming, to the site specified in this instant application, with an upgrade to Class C1 and a change in community of license from Thermopolis to Story, is being submitted by Legend, the permittee of KZZS.

Frequency Radiation exposure limits. Therefore, attached as Exhibit A is a study demonstrating that this facility, in conjunction with the other FM station, is in compliance with the Commission's Radio Frequency Radiation limits. All exhibits called for on FCC Form 301, Section III-B, are attached hereto. All other exhibits used to certify the application have been forwarded to Legend and are available for submission to the Commission upon request.
