
Dear Applicant:

The staff has under consideration the above-captioned application for a new low power FM (LPFM) station.

An engineering study has revealed that the proposed transmitter site specified in the application fails to meet the minimum spacing requirements of 47 C.F.R. § 73.807. Specifically, the site proposed is located 47.7 kilometers from the licensed facility for WEGX (BMLH-20070316ACC) on Channel 225C in Dillon, SC. The required spacing pursuant to § 73.807 is 93 kilometers. The application supplies a second adjacent short-spacing waiver request that does not adequately demonstrate that no interference will occur. The exhibit contained only a narrative claiming no interference. An adequate demonstration of no interference should contain additional various items such as a map, a diagram, a photograph, and/or the antenna manufacture's vertical pattern data. Therefore, the application is unacceptable for filing and will be dismissed.

Accordingly, in light of the above, application BNPL-20131029AEI is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a)¹ and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283

¹ Under the Public Notice entitled "Commission States Future Policy on Incomplete and Patently Defective AM and FM Construction Permit Applications," FCC 84-366, released August 2, 1984, the Commission indicated that it would reinstate applications *nunc pro tunc* where the original application was dismissed and where a minor curative amendment was filed within thirty days.
