Dear Ms. Dortch:

Radio Training Network, Inc. ("RTN") is filing an FCC Form 340 for a new FM station in Sebring, Florida (FacID: 81147).

The Commission has provided that requests for Waivers of the Main Studio Rule may be made by letter, without the need to file a modification application. *See, Commission Rules to Permit Certain Minor Changes in Broadcast Facilities Without a Construction Permit*, 12 FCC Rcd. 12371 at ¶37 (August 22, 1997).

As provided in Rule 73.1125(a)(4), the Commission will waive the Main Studio Rule where good cause is shown and where the proposed studio location "would be consistent with the operation of the station in the public interest." The Commission has recognized the benefits of centralized operations for noncommercial educational stations, given their limited resources, and has granted waivers of the Main Studio Rule where satellite operations are proposed. *See, Main Studio and Program Origination Rules*, 3 FCC Rcd. 5024, 5027 (1988). *See, also, American Family Association, (Marksville, Louisiana)*, 12 FCC Rcd. 15128 (Hearing Designation Order 1997). *Public Broadcasting in Northwest Ohio (Defiant, Ohio)*. 12 FCC Rcd. 15114 (Hearing Designation Order February 19, 1997); *Greater Washington Education Telecommunications Association, Inc., (Leonardtown, Maryland)*. 12 FCC Rcd. 15123 (1997).

RTN seeks waiver of the Main Studio Rule in order to operate the Sebring, Florida station as a satellite of the commonly owned station WJIS(FM), Bradenton, Florida (FacID: 54857). A waiver is necessary due to the limited funding available to noncommercial educational broadcast stations,

especially in small markets such as Sebring . The cost savings will help ensure the station's financial success.

In order to ensure that its public service obligations to Sebring, Florida are met, RTN agrees to undertake the following:

- (1) It will maintain the new Sebring, Florida FM public file in Sebring, Florida, the community of license as well as the main studio of WJIS(FM) in Bradenton, Florida.
- (2) It will establish toll-free phone service to the station for residents of Sebring, Florida.
- (3) It will provide periodic local programming for Sebring, Florida residents, including coverage of significant local news or cultural events.
- (4) It will ascertain community needs at least bi-annually.
- (5) It will establish a community advisory board consisting of at least one resident of Sebring, Florida. This board will provide input and recommendations on community needs and programming.
