

Exhibit 32 - Section 307(b)

AGM California (“AGM”), licensee of radio station KGFM(FM), Bakersfield, California, hereby submits this application (“Application”) which proposes to change the community of license of KGFM from Bakersfield to Edison, California while maintaining the station’s transmitter at KGFM’s licensed transmitter site. Specifically, the Application proposes to delete Channel 268B at Bakersfield, allot Channel 269A at Edison as that community’s first local service, and modify station KGFM’s license to specify operation at the new community.

As demonstrated in the Engineering Report of Delawder Communications, Inc. appended to this Application as Exhibit 26, Channel 269A can be allotted to Edison consistent with Section 73.207 of the Commission’s rules. A 70 dBu signal can be provided to Edison from the proposed reference coordinates. See Exhibit 26 and AGM’s response to FCC Form 301, Section III-B, Question 14. The proposed Channel 269A facility at Edison will provide a 70 dBu signal to 115,282 persons over 911.7 square kilometers, and a 60 dBu signal to 427,774 persons over 2,900.4 square kilometers.

AGM desires to change the community of license of KGFM from Bakersfield to Edison under the guidelines set forth in *Amendment of the Commission’s Rules Regarding Modification of FM and TV Authorizations to Specify a New Community of License*, 4 FCC Rcd 4870 (1989) (“*Change of Community R&O*”), *recon. granted in part*, 5 FCC Rcd 7094 (1990), and the new procedures adopted by the Commission in *Revision of Procedures Governing Amendment of FM Table of Allotments and Changes of Community of License in the Radio Broadcast Services*, 21 FCC Rcd 14212 (2006). This Application complies with the criteria set forth in *Change of Community R&O* and Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §307(b). First, the proposed use of Channel 269A at Edison (population of 435) is mutually exclusive with the current use of Channel 268B at Bakersfield. Second,

Bakersfield will not be deprived of its only local service. Third, the provision of a first local service to Edison under Priority 3 will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments over retaining 19 local services at Bakersfield¹ (2000 U.S. Census population of 286,316) under the fourth allotment priority. *See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1982).

The city of Edison, California is an unincorporated community located in Kern County, California, east of Bakersfield. *See 2007 Rand McNally Road Atlas* at 14. Edison has a population of 435.² Edison is a major farming community that provides potatoes, carrots and many other agricultural products. Edison has its own post office which is located at 12299 Edison Highway in Edison and its own zip code (93220). Edison is home to the Edison School District which provides the community with Orangewood Elementary School and Edison Middle School. Orangewood Elementary School educates students from kindergarten through the 4th grade, and has an approximate enrollment of 590 students. Edison Middle School has students in grades 5-8 and has an approximate enrollment of 566. Both schools provide a vast array of activities for their students. *See Appendix*. According to 2004 U.S. Census Bureau data, there are at least 15 separate business establishments within Edison that employ 183 persons. The collective annual payroll of those persons is \$6,338,000. There also are two churches in Edison. *See Appendix*.

The Commission has previously found this type of indicia sufficient to establish community status for allotment purposes. *See, e.g., Kenansville, Florida*, 5 FCC Rcd 2663, 2664

Div. 1990) (finding city with population of 700 not listed in census reports with similar commercial activity to be community for allotment purposes), *aff'd*, 10 FCC Rcd 9831 (1995); *Powhatan and Goochland, Virginia*, 12 FCC Rcd 3191, 3192-93 (MMB 1997) (finding Powhatan and Goochland to be communities for allotment purposes despite their exclusion from census reports); *see also Encino, Texas*, 18 FCC Rcd 23984 (MB 2003) (finding Encino to be a community for allotment purposes where it was a Census Designated Place with a population of 110 persons and having comparable community indicia); *Marathon and Mertzon, Texas*, 18 FCC Rcd 23986 (MB 2003) (finding Marathon to be a community for allotment purposes where it was a Census Designated Place with a population of 455 persons and having comparable community indicia).

An analysis of AGM's reallocation proposal pursuant to *Faye and Richard Tuck*, 3 FCC Rcd 5374 (1988) ("*Tuck*") is not necessary because station KGFM is already located in the Bakersfield Urbanized Area. *See, e.g., Okmulgee and Glenpool, Oklahoma*, 18 FCC Rcd 14370 (MB 2003); *Lampasas and Leander, Texas*, 15 FCC Rcd 6113, 6113-14 (MMB 2000); *Athens and Doraville, Georgia*, 18 FCC Rcd 17627, 17628 (MB 2003) (NPRM).

The deletion of Channel 268B at Bakersfield, allotment of Channel 269A at Edison, and corresponding modification of the KGFM station license to specify operation at the new community will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments. The FM allotment priorities are: (1) first full-time aural service; (2) second full-time aural service; (3) first local service; and (4) other public interest factors. Co-equal weight is given to priorities (2) and (3). *See Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1982).

Priorities 1 and 2 are not implicated in this case because both Bakersfield and Edison will continue to receive more than five reception services and, thus, will be well served.³ *See Eatonton and Lexington, Georgia*, 21 FCC Rcd 10032, 10034 (MB 2006). As stated above, the proposed allotment of Channel 269A to Edison will serve Priority 3 because it will provide that community with its first local service. The provision of a first local service serves a higher allotment than continuing to retain 19 local transmission services at Bakersfield, which serves only the fourth allotment priority.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission should delete Channel 268B at Bakersfield, allot Channel 269A at Edison, and modify station KGFM's license to specify operation on Channel 269A at the new community.
