Quote...Unquote, Inc. is a 501c3 media non-profit organization founded in Albuquerque in March of 1979. The Federal Tax ID number is 85-0274531 and New Mexico Certificate of Incorporation Number 1950990.

Mission of Quote...Unquote, Inc.: "Quote...Unquote's mission is to operate as a community media center to enhance and facilitate communication by, for and among the diverse people of Albuquerque and New Mexico. Quote...Unquote provides the means to train people, and to promote, balanced community programming. "

For many years Quote...Unquote has been involved in producing media in New Mexico, including founding the access television channels in Albuquerque. The organization has provided access and media training to more than 9,000 people over the years. One of its priorities is working with schools to provide training and media access to students and teachers. Quote...Unquote has worked with dozens of schools in the Albuquerque area and has specific partnerships with two high schools that it will be working with if granted the LPFM license. These are the Media Arts Collaborative Charter School which was founded by Quote...Unquote in 2007 and has a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Quote...Unquote, and the Robert F. Kennedy Charter School which contracts with Quote...Unquote for work with students and faculty to support the school with technologies and teacher professional development. Two of the principal leaders of Quote...Unquote, are certified, professional teachers, licensed by the State of New Mexico, Colleen Gorman, and Steven Ranieri.

Educational Program and Goals For Quote Unquote and LPFM

The station will be serving, primarily, the South Valley of Albuquerque and southern Bernalillo County. This is a broad semi-rural area, heavily Hispanic and largely low income. The South Valley dates back to the 1700's and the Spanish land grants of that time such as the Atrisco Land Grant amongst others. The cultural heritage of the area is a treasure for the State of New Mexico while at the same time there is a tremendous need to bring youth and the areas cultural heritage together if the South Valley is going to overcome poverty, and improve educational opportunities.

Quote...Unquote's goal is to aid the residents and schools of the area through the use of media, concentrating on improving the educational levels of the South Valley while creating a more cohesive community amongst the generations. The use of radio to inform regarding events and local problems will coincide with providing opportunities for youth and elders to learn how to effectively get their messages out through broadcast training conducted by Quote...Unquote. Quote...Unquote will be working to get high school students academic credits for their participation in Radio Burque. One of our partners in this endeavor is the Robert F. Kennedy Charter Public High School which concentrates on giving hundreds of students another chance to graduate. Quote...Unquote, Inc. also works with many other local organizations, especially local non-profits. Quote Unquote's LPFM will further its mission by providing a new type of facility to create local programming.
