

Exhibit 15 (Section IV Question 6(b))

Prior to the death of Jack I. Mullen on June 26, 1996, the following was the ownership structure of Starcast Systems, Inc. (“Licensee”)¹:

Jack I. Mullen (prior to death)

- 210 shares (52.5% interest)
- President and Director

Jack I. Mullen, II

- 60 shares (15% interest)
- Vice President and Director

Curtis E. Durst

- 60 shares (15% interest)
- Secretary, Treasurer, and Director

William P. Kelly, Jr.

- 70 shares (17.5% interest)
- Director

On June 26, 1996, Jack I. Mullen passed away.

On or about December 6, 1996, 30 shares (7.5% interest) were transferred from Jack I. Mullen, II to Donna E. Mullen (now known as Donna E. Michael) as per the FCC’s grant of an FCC 316 transfer of control application (FCC File Nos. BTCH-19961125GE and BTCH-19961125FG; Granted December 6, 1996). At this time, the Licensee was unaware that an involuntary transfer of control application was necessary to transfer the interests of Jack I. Mullen following his death on June 26, 1996. However, once the Licensee learned of the requirement, the Licensee filed an FCC 316 involuntary transfer of control application on June 4, 1999 transferring the 210 shares (52.5% interest) held by Jack I. Mullen to Jean C. Mullen (as Personal Representative of the Estate of Jack I. Mullen) (FCC File Nos. BTCH-19990604GH and BTCH-19990604GI; Granted June 21, 1999).

On or about December 12, 1997, the Estate of Jack I. Mullen was distributed and the 210 shares (52.5% interest) held by Jean C. Mullen (as Personal Representative of the Estate of Jack I. Mullen) was transferred to Jean C. Mullen (as an individual). An FCC 315 transfer of control application was not filed.

On March 1, 2003, Jean C. Mullen passed away. Thereafter, the 210 shares (52.5% interest) held by Jean C. Mullen (as an individual) was transferred to Jack I. Mullen, II and Jean Ann Mullen (as Personal Representatives of the Estate of Jean C. Mullen). An FCC 316 involuntary transfer of control application was not filed.

¹ The familial relationships among the parties in interest are as follows: Jack I. Mullen and Jean C. Mullen were husband and wife. Jack I. Mullen, II and Jean Ann Mullen are the children of Jack I. Mullen and Jean C. Mullen. Donna E. Mullen (now known as Donna E. Michael) is the ex-wife of Jack I. Mullen, II.

The instant FCC 315 transfer of control application seeks the FCC's consent to transfer the 210 shares (52.5% interest) now held by Jack I. Mullen, II and Jean Ann Mullen (as Personal Representatives of the Estate of Jean C. Mullen) to Jack I. Mullen (as an individual) so that the following will be the ownership structure of the Licensee.

Jack I. Mullen, II

- 240 shares (60% interest)²
- Acting President and Director

Curtis E. Durst

- 60 shares (15% interest)
- Secretary, Treasurer, and Director

William P. Kelly, Jr.

- 70 shares (17.5% interest)

Donna E. Michael (formerly known as Donna E. Mullen)

- 30 shares (7.5% interest)

² The total shares of Jack I. Mullen, II consists of 30 shares (7.5%) already held by Jack I. Mullen, II and the 210 shares (52.5%) from the Estate of Jean C. Mullen which is currently held by Jack I. Mullen, II and Jean Ann Mullen (as Personal Representatives of the Estate of Jean C. Mullen).
