Radio Vision Cristiana Management ("Radio Vision") is licensee of Stations WWCL(AM) and WVZN(AM), and is the parent company of Radio Vision Subsidiary Corp., licensee of Station KCKN(AM).

The Board of Directors of Radio Vision has voted to change the above three stations to COMMERCIAL status after years of voluntary noncommercial operation. This is necessitated by financial issues of station viability. Radio Vision has two other noncommercial radio stations – WWRV(AM), New York, NY and WRVP(AM), Mt. Kisco, NY – which will remain as noncommercial operations. The Mission Statement of Radio Vision (below) allows for both commercial and noncommercial operations by Radio Vision in order to fund the stations' non-profit educational purposes.

WWCL(AM), Lehigh Acres, FL, File No. BL-20150320ABZ, expires on Feb. 1, 2020. It operates as a satellite of co-owned noncommercial station WWRV(AM), New York, NY.

WVZN(AM), Columbia, Pennsylvania, File No. BML-20110602ADM, expires on Aug. 1, 2022. It operates as a satellite of co-owned noncommercial station WWRV(AM), New York, NY.

KCKN(AM), Roswell, New Mexico, File No. BML-20111129GCM, expires on Oct. 1, 2021. It operates as a satellite of co-owned noncommercial station WWRV(AM), New York, NY.

MISSION STATEMENT OF RADIO VISION CRISTIANA MANAGEMENT
