I, the undersigned individual, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the Montana Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

Article 1 - Name

The name of this corporation is HELENA PUBLIC RADIO ASSOCIATION, INC.

Article 2 - Duration

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

Article 3 - Purpose

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Such purposes shall include:

A. To maintain and preserve an FM radio translator in Helena, Montana, used to rebroadcast station KUFM originating from the University of Montana in Missoula.

B. To establish a suitable site for the translator at a location in Helena, Montana.

C. To raise needed funds to meet operation and maintenance costs.

D. To inform and educate the public on matters important to the preservation of public radio in Helena.

Article 4 - Status under State Law

This corporation is organized under Title 35, Chapter 2, of the Montana Codes Annotated, known as the Montana Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Article 5 - Nonprofit Nature

A. This corporation is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any individual. This corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

B. Upon dissolution of this corporation, any assets remaining after provision is made for paying the corporation's liabilities shall be distributed only to one or more funds, foundations or corporations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which have established entitlement to tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Article 6 - Status under Federal Law

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not:

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A. Carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to which contributions are deductible under Section 170 of said Code;

B. Have the power to, and shall not, participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office;

C. Carry on propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, to an extent which would disqualify it for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

D. All references in these articles to the Internal Revenue Code are to the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article 7 - Governance

A. The corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors.

B. The initial Board of Directors will consist of the following three individuals, who shall serve until their successors are elected:

C. A director may be removed from office, for cause, by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors.

Article 8 - Registered Agent and Office

The initial registered agent and office of the corporation shall be: Patricia Borneman, 100 Jefferson, Helena, Montana 59601.

Article 9 - Amendments

These Articles may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors.
