You propose to increase the radiated power of WVMC on channel 214 to 170 watts, vertically polarized.

My engineering consultant advises me that such power is within the rules regarding NCFM stations and channel 6 television stations. Although we anticipate that some theoretical interference will result, we do not believe WSYX is receiving any in the Mansfield area, so actual interference should not result.

On this basis, WSYX will not object to such an application, provided that you provide us with a copy of the application amendments or modifications to it. Further, in the event that interference is actually observed, WVMC will take all reasonable steps to eliminate it promptly.


