

Compliance with Special Operating Conditions

The Construction Permit contains several Special Operating Conditions, summarized as follows:

1. The permittee/licensee, in coordination with other users of the site, must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
2. Waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 is granted to allow operation of the facility authorized by this construction permit as a satellite operation of station KLVR-FM.
3. The permittee must provide the results of a complete proof-of-performance to establish the horizontal plane radiation patterns for both the horizontally and vertically polarized radiation components.
4. The permittee must provide an affidavit from a licensed surveyor to establish that the directional antenna has been oriented at the proper azimuth.
5. The permittee must submit an affidavit that a qualified engineer oversaw the installation of the directional antenna system.
6. The permittee must submit an exhibit demonstrating that the measured directional antenna pattern complies with the appropriate community coverage provisions of 47 C.F.R. Sections 73.315 or 73.515.
7. The permittee must provide a statement that the relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component exceeds, at any azimuth, the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by the construction permit.

Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), complies with, or agrees to, these conditions, as follows:

1. EMF agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
