Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority

Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of United Broadcasting Company ("United"), Licensee of radio station KTKK (AM), Sandy, Utah, we respectfully request an extension of special temporary authority ("STA") for an additional six months for the station to continue operating at variance from its licensed parameters. (See 47 C.F.R. § 73.1740(a)(4) and 73.1635.) In support of this request, the following delineation of our efforts and current status is offered:

In 1997, KTKK was forced to vacate its licensed tower site. On September 24, 1998, the licensee filed an initial STA to operate at the KLLB(AM), West Jordan, Utah, antenna site. The Commission granted this request on November 3, 1998. (FCC File Number BSTA-19980924YC.) The STA was renewed repeatedly thereafter based on the lack of a tower site and the licensee's efforts to find a new one.

KTKK requests extension of the STA to operate with temporary facilities as in BSTA-20061011AFD because of the loss of the licensed site. A new site has been located, and application BMJP-20041029AJK to use the new site is pending.

We feel that substantial progress has been made during this most recent STA period toward being able to apply for a permanent facility with reasonable assurance that it could actually be built. Therefore, we respectfully request extension of the STA so that the public may receive uninterrupted service.

United certifies that no party to the application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862. This STA request is accompanied by the appropriate filing fee of \$160.00 and completed FCC Form 159.
