Request for Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Martin:

This letter concerns the request you filed on December 8, 2011, on behalf of Sonshine Radio Corporation ("SRC"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Low Power Radio Station WSRD-LP to remain silent.

SRC's request states that Station WSRD-LP went silent on June 18, 2011, for technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.¹

SRC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WSRD-LP to remain silent until June 18, 2012. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WSRD-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., June 19, 2012.**² See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. See 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).

Finally, Section 73.1740(a)(4) of the Commission's Rules permits licensees to discontinue operations for good cause, and for a period not to exceed 30 days without further authority. See 47 C.F.R. § 73.1740(a)(4). This rule requires that the licensee notify the Commission by letter "not later than the 10th day of limited or discontinued operations," and if operations are not able to commence by the 10th day, "informal written request shall be made to the FCC no later than the 30th day for such additional time as may be deemed necessary." SRC failed to submit a timely request for an STA to permit Station

WSRD-LP to remain silent beyond July 18, 2011, and the action taken herein shall not be construed as authorizing the station to remain silent between July 18, 2011, and December 8, 2011.
