

AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR MINOR CHANGE

To: Federal Communications Commission

This is an application for a minor change in the facilities of Non-Commercial Educational FM Broadcast Station WTMK, Lowell, Indiana, to change station location from Lowell to Wanatah, Indiana. A grant of the application will result in a preferential arrangement of allotments, consistent with the Commission's obligations under §307(b) of the Communications Act.

Lowell, Indiana is an incorporated community of 7,505 persons (2000 Census). Wanatah, Indiana is an incorporated community of 1,013 persons (2000 Census). Thus, Wanatah is somewhat smaller than Lowell.

Lowell, however, has two FM broadcast stations licensed to serve its needs, including Station WTMK. Furthermore, Lowell is part of the Chicago Metropolitan Area, as defined by the Census Bureau. Wanatah, on the other hand, has no broadcast stations licensed to serve its local needs. Thus, if the Commission grants the subject application, the grant will serve one of the Commission's FM Assignment Priorities, *i.e.*, the establishment of a first local broadcast service. At the same time, the grant will not violate any of the Commission's FM Assignment Priorities.

The community of Wanatah has its own website. Attached hereto are materials, copied from the website, establishing that Wanatah is an incorporated town, with its own local government and community institutions. Thus, Wanatah qualifies as a community, for assignment purposes.

For the above reasons, a grant of the application will create a preferential arrangement of allotments and will serve the public interest.
