NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF TRANSFER

By the instant application, the parties seek prior Commission consent to transfer control of Marathon Media Group, L.L.C. (“Company”) from Bruce Buzil to a five person governing Board of the Company, the majority of whom have not previously been passed upon as control persons in connection with the Company.

At the present time, the Company is a single member owned and controlled limited liability company. Marathon Media, L.P. (“Partnership”) is the sole member and manager of the Company. After Commission consent, and upon consummation of the transaction, the Company will be a board controlled limited liability company, with no change in the Partnership’s ownership interests in the Company.

The Partnership is controlled by its sole general partner, Marathon Media, Inc. (“Marathon, Inc.”). Marathon, Inc. also holds 100% of the equity of the Partnership. The limited partners of the Partnership are: Bruce Buzil, Andrew Barrett, Aaron Shainis, Peter Handy and Northland Holding Trust.

Marathon, Inc. is a single majority shareholder corporation. Bruce Buzil is the 66.66% voting shareholder of Marathon, Inc. and the Christopher F. Devine Irrevocable Trust is the 33.33% voting shareholder of Marathon, Inc. There are three directors of Marathon, Inc.: Bruce Buzil, Andrew Barrett and Peter Handy.

Under this transaction, Mr. Buzil will be relinquishing his positive voting control of the Company (through his positive control of Marathon, Inc.) to a five person board of the Company in which he will be one of five members and thus have the equivalent of 20% voting control.

The board of the Company will be comprised of: Andrew Barrett, Christopher F. Devine, Peter S. Handy, Charles D. Schwartz and Jonathan D. Schwartz. Each board member will have an equal 20% vote on matters brought before the board.
