CHANGE OF AUTHORIZED COMMUNITIES STATEMENT
YOUNGERS COORADO BROADCASTING LLC
KEZZ PHIPPSBURG, COLORADO 231C2
FCC FORM 301

The applicant, Youngers Colorado Broadcasting LLC, seeks to modify the CP of KEZZ (facility I.D. 165959) at Walden, Colorado on channel 231C3, to minor change its authorized community from Walden to Phippsburg, Colorado. It also seeks to change its transmitter location and is proposing an upgrade in class of operation from 231C3 to 231C2.

The minor change of the authorized community is pursuant to the new provisions of MB Docket 05-210 which became effective on January 19th, 2007. This docket allows for city of license changes, under certain provisions, to be filed as a minor change application on FCC form 301 for AM and FM broadcast stations.

Youngers Colorado Broadcasting LLC believes this application meets the provisions under this new docket for a change in authorized communities for KEZZ. The docket emphasizes the desire to avoid any losses of service to communities while providing the most efficient usage of spectrum. KEZZ was acquired in auction 62 but has not yet been constructed. Therefore, if the authorized community is changed from Walden to Phippsburg, Walden will experience no actual loss of service from what it is currently receiving and will continue at its present service level of nine primary signals from stations in other communities. The proposed new community, Phippsburg, Colorado, does not have a commercial AM, FM or TV station authorized to it, thus, it

will be the community's first local service. This new proposed service to Phippsburg will also provide a new 1st and 2nd service.

The Rand McNally 2000 Commercial Atlas & Marketing Guide estimated the 2000 population of Phippsburg at 180 persons. It has grown over 70% to a current population of 309 persons. Conversely, Walden's population declined over 10% from 1990 to 2000, and it has declined an additional 23% since 2000. Thus, the public interest supports a change of allotments from Walden, which will remain at its current licensed service level, while Phippsburg will benefit from its first local service. It should also be noted that channel 226C3 has been allotted at Walden, Colorado should the Commission determine that an FM allotment is still warranted at Walden.

Under the Instructions for the FCC form 301, under item 18, it calls for the following information to be included:

- 1) If new technical facilities are proposed, the area and population with the proposed 70 dB μ and 60 dB μ contours of the station: The new proposed contours for the new facility at Phippsburg will be: 60 dB μ : 18,831 persons and an area of 4,862 sq. km, 70 dB μ : 14,895 persons and an area of 1,611 sq. km. The coverage within the current CP facility on channel 230C3 at Walden is: 60 dB μ : 1,199 persons and an area of 1,801 sq. km., 70 dB μ : 958 persons and an area of 598 sq. km.
- 2) The number of stations licensed to the proposed new community of license: There is no commercial AM, FM or TV station licensed to Phippsburg, Colorado. This will be the community's first local service.

- 3) The number of stations providing protected service to the proposed community of license: There are 8 commercial and 3 noncommercial FM stations that cover the new community with 60 dB μ service or greater. There are 4 AM stations that cover the new community with 0.5 mv/m coverage or greater.
- 4) The population, according to the latest Census Data, of the proposed community of license: The Rand McNally 2000 Commercial Atlas & Marketing Guide estimated the 2000 population of Phippsburg at 180 persons.
- 5) Where relevant to establish the precondition of a licensable community, a description of the civic, cultural, religious, social and commercial attributes of the proposed community of license: The proposed community of license, Phippsburg, Colorado, has its own Post Office with a zip code of 80469.
