NATURE OF THE PROPOSAL

Combined Communications Corp. of Oklahoma, Inc. (“*Oklahoma*”) is the permittee of digital television station WZZM(TV), digital Channel 13, Grand Rapids, Michigan (see BMPCDT-20080620ANB, “CP”). *Oklahoma* has constructed the facility authorized in the CP and filed an application for license (see BLCDT-20090619ACQ). Now, *Oklahoma* seeks to increase the station’s effective radiated power (“ERP”) using the existing, authorized antenna system.

The currently authorized WZZM site is proposed for the maximized operation (see Antenna Structure Registration Number 1234009). Since the existing antenna will be employed, no construction or change in structure height and marking will be required.

Exhibit 45 - Figure 1 provides a map depicting the service contour for the proposed facility along with principal community coverage contour. As demonstrated therein, the principal community of Grand Rapids, Michigan is predicted to receive the enhanced signal level as required in §73.625(a) of the Commission’s Rules. The proposed facility is predicted to provide interference free service to 1,434,247 persons, which is 103 percent of the 1,392,000 persons that are predicted to receive interference free service from the Appendix B facility¹.

The proposed antenna is the existing Dielectric TW-12B13-R which is non-directional in the horizontal plane and is horizontally polarized with 0.75° of electrical beam tilt. The antenna’s height above average terrain is in excess of 305 meters. Therefore, a calculation was performed in accordance Section 73.622(f)(7)(ii) of the Commission Rules to determine the station’s proposed ERP of 24.5 kW, the maximum for a Television Zone 1 high-band VHF station.

Since the proposed facility extends the service contour past that currently authorized for the Appendix B facility, post-transition interference studies were performed in accordance with the

methods set forth in the Commission's OET Bulletin No 69 ("OET-69"). The results of the studies indicate that no new interference in excess of the 0.5% limit established in the Commission's Third Periodic Review² is caused to affected stations by the maximized WZZM(TV) operation with the exception of WREX(TV), digital Channel 13, Facility ID 73940, Rockford, Illinois. Accordingly, *Oklahoma* and WREX Television, LLC, licensee of WREX, have entered into an agreement related to acceptance of interference. A copy of that agreement is provided as **Exhibit 45 - Attachment I**. A summary of the post-transition interference study is provided in the attached **Exhibit 45 - Table I**.

There are no AM stations located within 3.2 km of the existing tower site. The proposed site is located 78 km from the FCC Monitoring Station in Allegan, Michigan. The proposed power level is below the threshold average ERP specified in Section 73.1030(c)(3)(iv) of the Commission's Rules to warrant consideration of the monitoring station. The proposed WZZM(TV) digital Channel 13 site is located 257 km from the nearest point on the international border with Canada. As such, international coordination is respectfully requested.

Thus, this proposal is believed to be in compliance with the current Commission's Rules and policy with respect to allocation matters.

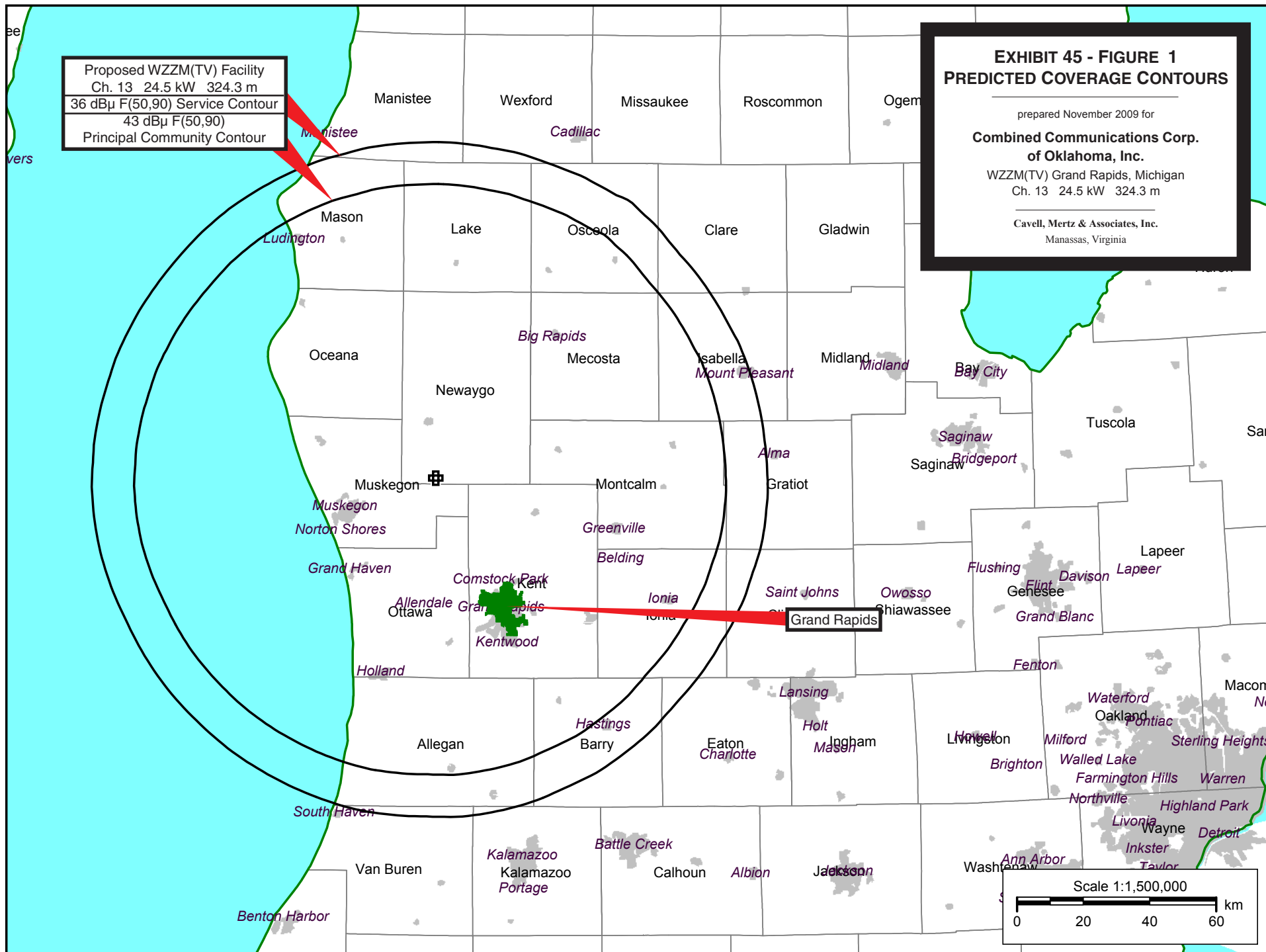

INTERFERENCE AGREEMENT

This Interference Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of October 28, 2009 by and between Combined Communications Corporation of Oklahoma, Inc., ("CCC"), licensee of WZZM, Grand Rapids, Michigan (FIN 49713) ("WZZM") and WREX Television, LLC ("WREX Television, LLC"), licensee of WREX, Rockford, Illinois (FIN 73940) ("WREX").

1. WZZM is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to operate on digital Channel 13 in Grand Rapids, Michigan. WREX is authorized by the FCC to operate on digital Channel 13 in Rockford, Illinois.

2. WZZM proposes to increase its authorized power from its currently authorized effective radiated power ("ERP") of 16.5kW ERP at 324.4 meters height above average terrain ("HAAT") to an ERP of 24.5kW at 324.4 meters HAAT ("WZZM's Power Increase") and intends to file an application with the FCC for such authorization.

3. Pursuant to an engineering survey, it is predicted that WZZM's Power Increase will cause 1.7237% signal interference to WREX's Appendix B facilities, as determined by the FCC, and 2.1323% signal interference to WREX's authorized operations of 18kW ERP at 216 meters HAAT.

4. In the event that WREX increases its authorized power from 18kW ERP at 216 meters HAAT to 24.4kW ERP at 216 meters HAAT, it is predicted that WZZM's Power Increase will cause 2.7526% signal interference to WREX's broadcast operations at 24.4kW ERP at 216 meters HAAT.

5. WREX Television, LLC hereby agrees to accept the predicted signal interference levels described above from WZZM to WREX and CCC hereby agrees to reimburse WREX Television, LLC for its reasonable and actual engineering and legal consulting fees incurred in connection with analyzing and negotiating this Agreement, up to a maximum total of \$1,500.00 ("Reimbursable Expenses"), collectively, regardless of whether CCC files an application with the FCC to increase authorized power for WZZM. WREX Television, LLC shall issue an invoice to CCC documenting such Reimbursable Expenses, and CCC, through its corporate payment facility, shall deliver the Reimbursable Expenses to WREX Television, LLC by check upon the complete execution of this Agreement. WREX Television, LLC's agreement herein is limited to the predicted signal interference levels described herein and should not be construed to extend to any other facilities proposed or to be proposed by either WZZM or WREX in the future, unless otherwise agreed to by both CCC and WREX Television, LLC.

6. CCC agrees that it will give WREX Television, LLC advance notice of any material change to WZZM's Power Increase proposal that would increase the level or geographic area of predicted interference to WREX beyond that predicted to result herein. Such notice shall be provided in a timely fashion in order to provide WREX Television, LLC sufficient time to review and assess the impact of the proposed change(s). In the event that CCC modifies WZZM's Power Increase proposal in such a manner as to increase the interference predicted to occur herein, WREX Television, LLC, without incurring any liability or continuing obligation of any kind, may terminate this Agreement by written notice.

7. WZZM shall include a fully-executed version of this Agreement in its application with the FCC for such power increase.

8. Each party represents and warrants to the other that the officer executing this Agreement for such party has all necessary power and authority to enter into this Agreement on behalf of such party, and that this Agreement is a valid and binding agreement of such party, enforceable according to its term.

9. Except for the consideration and the mutual promises set forth in this Agreement, no further consideration, financial or otherwise is required or promised by either party. This Agreement shall be governed and constructed according to the laws of the District of Columbia, the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and the rules and regulations of the FCC.


10. This Agreement may be signed in counterparts with the same effect as if the signature on each counterpart were upon the same instrument. Electronic copies of signatures shall be treated as originals for all purposes.
