### **Purpose of Application And Information Concerning Composition of Board of Trustees**

Noncommercial educational FM Station WLFR(FM) is licensed to the Richard Stockton College of New Jersey (“RSCNJ”) (formerly known as Stockton State College). RSCNJ is a four-year college established by the State of New Jersey and subject to the administrative supervision of the New Jersey Commission on Higher Education. RSCNJ is governed by a Board of Trustees appointed by the Governor of New Jersey (with the exception of two Student Trustees – a voting Trustee and an Alternate – who are appointed by the student body). Each Board member (except for the Student Alternate Member) has one vote, and each serves for a six-year term.

The purpose of the instant application is to obtain Commission consent to the current membership of RSCNJ’s Board.

Station WLFR(FM) was first authorized in 1984. Ownership Reports (FCC Form 323-E) were submitted to the Commission in 1984 (in conjunction with the station’s initial authorization) and in 1991 and 1998 (in conjunction with the station’s routine license renewal applications filed in those years – both of which were granted). Review of those Ownership Reports, and comparison with the current membership of the RSCNJ Board, indicates that the composition of the Board has gradually changed over the course of the 21-year period from 1984-2005, as reflected in the following table:

Since the transfer of control of the licensee took place gradually over a period of time, the transfer may be treated as insubstantial. *See, e.g., Transfers of Control of Certain Non-Stock Entities*, 4 FCC Rcd 3403 (1989). However, in view of the length of time involved and the degree of change in the composition of the Board, consent is hereby being sought on a Form 315.

There are no written agreements concerning transfer of control because the changes have occurred gradually through the ordinary process of attrition and appointment of new Trustees.
