


DECLARATION RE ESTABLISHED COMMUNITY PRESENCE

I, John W. Hull, President of Christian Media, Incorporated, an applicant for a permit to construct a new LPFM station at Columbus, Ohio, have personal knowledge of the facts specified below and, accordingly, declare as follows:

- 1) The applicant has continuously operated as a publicly supported, non-profit educational organization for thirteen years; it was formed on November 29, 1999, under the laws of the State of Ohio. (Copies of the applicant's Articles of Incorporation, as well as its Statement of Continued Existence of Corporation – Not for Profit, are attached.)
- 2) Three individuals are principals in the applicant; each serves as both an officer and a director. All three are residents of the metropolitan Columbus, Ohio, area (one lives in Columbus proper, and two live in Westerville, Ohio, a northeastern suburb of Columbus), and all reside within twelve miles of the coordinates of the proposed LPFM transmitting antenna. Columbus, Ohio, is ranked as the 37<sup>th</sup> radio market. (A copy of relevant pages from the Fall 2013 Nielsen radio market rankings is attached.) Accordingly, the locations of the principals' residences satisfy the requirement that they be no more than 20 miles from the transmitter site.

I hereby declare, under penalty of perjury, that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 13<sup>th</sup> day of November 2013 at Columbus, Ohio.
