

Showing under §307(b) of the Communications Act

Applicant is applying to change the community of license of station WBLL(AM) from Bellefontaine, OH to Grandview Heights, OH. The proposed change of community of license satisfies the Commission's established priorities for such determinations.¹

Applicant's proposal will bring a first local transmission service to Grandview Heights and is, therefore, entitled to preference as under Priority 3 of the *FM Assignment Policies*. Grandview Heights is a community for allotment purposes. It is a community listed in the 2000 U.S. Census with a population of 6,695. Grandview Heights is an independent city with its own government and school system. It has both a mayor and city council. Bellefontaine will continue to be served by WPKO-FM. Accordingly, Bellefontaine will not be deprived of its only local service.
